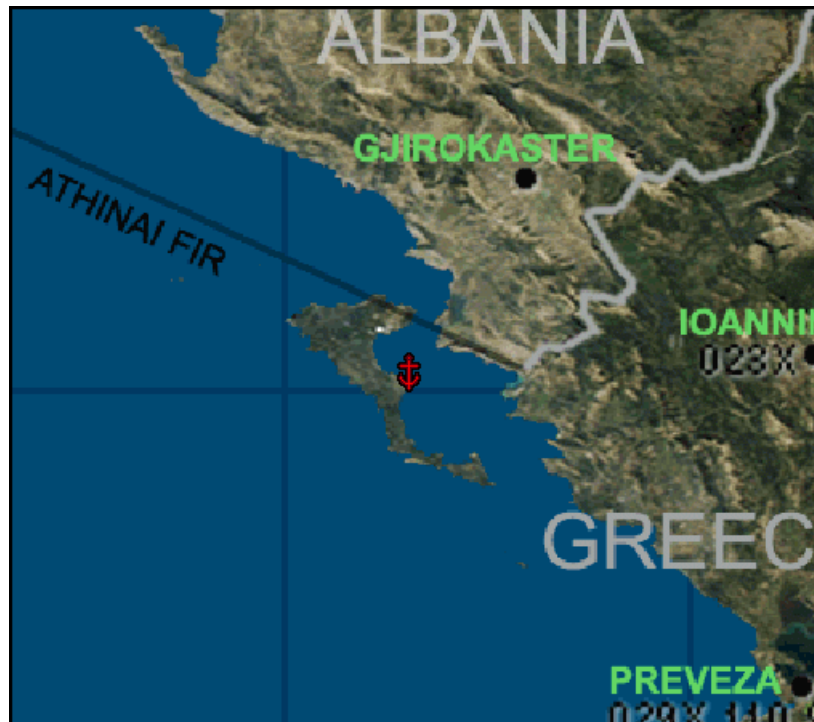

Situation:

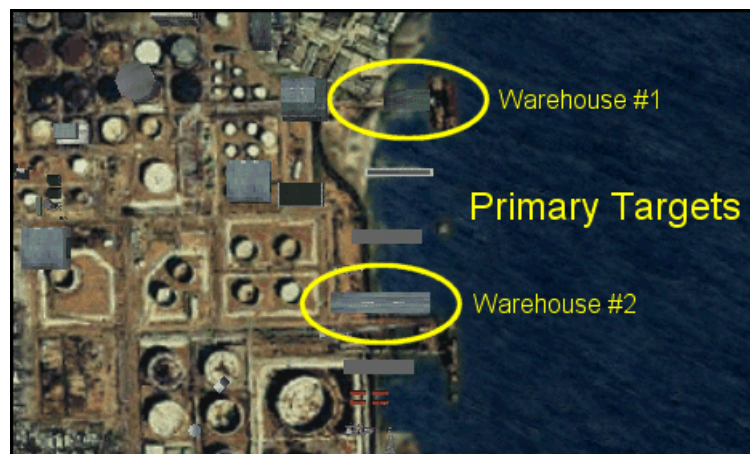
Today's mission will be a strike against two warehouses at the Port at Kerkyra, off the coast of Albania. It is known the port is being used as a re-arming point for Serbia-Montenegrin patrol boats. Two warehouses have been identified as being used for spare parts and weapons storage.

Recon:

The port is located on an island just off the coast, near the border between Albania and Greece:



This satellite image shows clearly the two warehouses we are particularly interested in:



Although we are keen to avoid collateral damage, the whole port has been reclassified as a strategically important military target, so the more damage we do this visit, the less chance there is we'll have to go back into this heavily defended area again.

SAM coverage is known to be very high in the area – there is an SA-2 installation defending the port itself, another on the mainland due west of the target area, and several SA-5 sites defending regional airbases also. However, it is safe to assume there are other installations we don't know about. A flight of 4 F/A-18D has been tasked to destroy the SA-5 at Gjirokaster Airport as this has been deemed the greatest long-range threat to your package.
