## BACKGROUND

South Korea has all but been overrun by the invading DPRK. However, the limited US and ROK Forces in theatre at the time of the assault held the Pusan perimeter, and since reinforcements have arrived from the USA, the DPRK advance has steadily been slowed. The liberation of South Korea will begin now.

## CURRENT SITUATION

Currently, the DPRK still have at their disposal a varied array of combat aircraft, including limited numbers of MiG-23s and MiG-27s, as well as vast numbers of MiG-17s and MiG-21s. Known SAM systems available to them include SA-2, SA-4, SA-5 and SA-6 types, but this list is far from exhaustive. Numerous KS-12/KS-19 AAA equipped battalions have also been identified.

## MISSION DETAILS

**Target:** This mornings' mission calls for a dual strike against two strategically important bridges – Hwangji and Bonghwa. Both bridges span the Nakdong River at its northern-most end, and disabling both will severely hamper enemy ground troops in the area.

*Cowboy* flight has been tasked with destroying the Hwangji Bridge, as seen here:



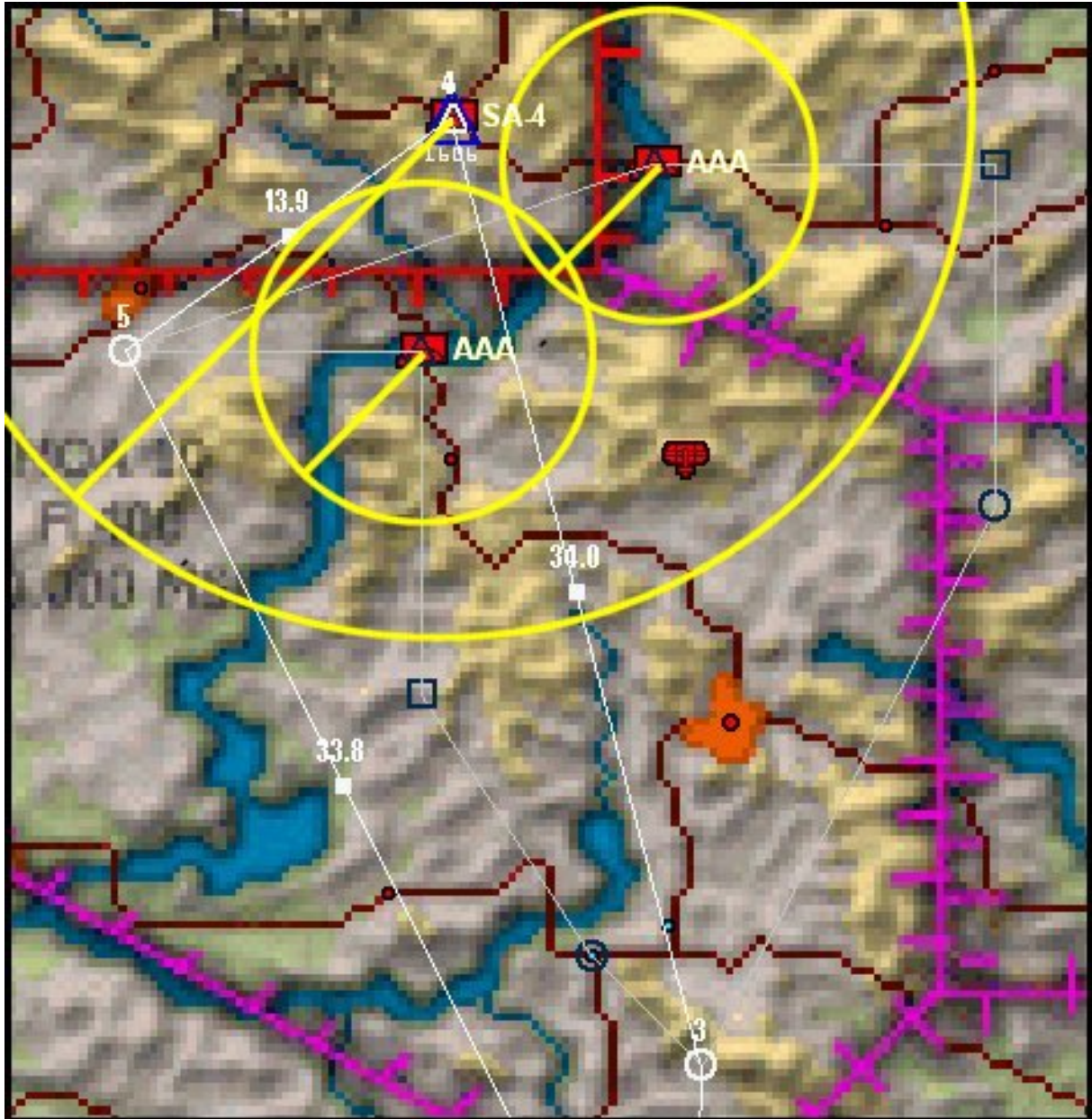
The bridge runs East-West, and is seen here from a viewpoint looking North. For maximum effect, aim to put your weapons on the central tower.

*Falcon* flight has been tasked with destroying the Bonghwa Bridge, as seen here:



The bridge runs North-South, and is seen here from a viewpoint looking East. For maximum effect, aim to put your weapons on the central span.

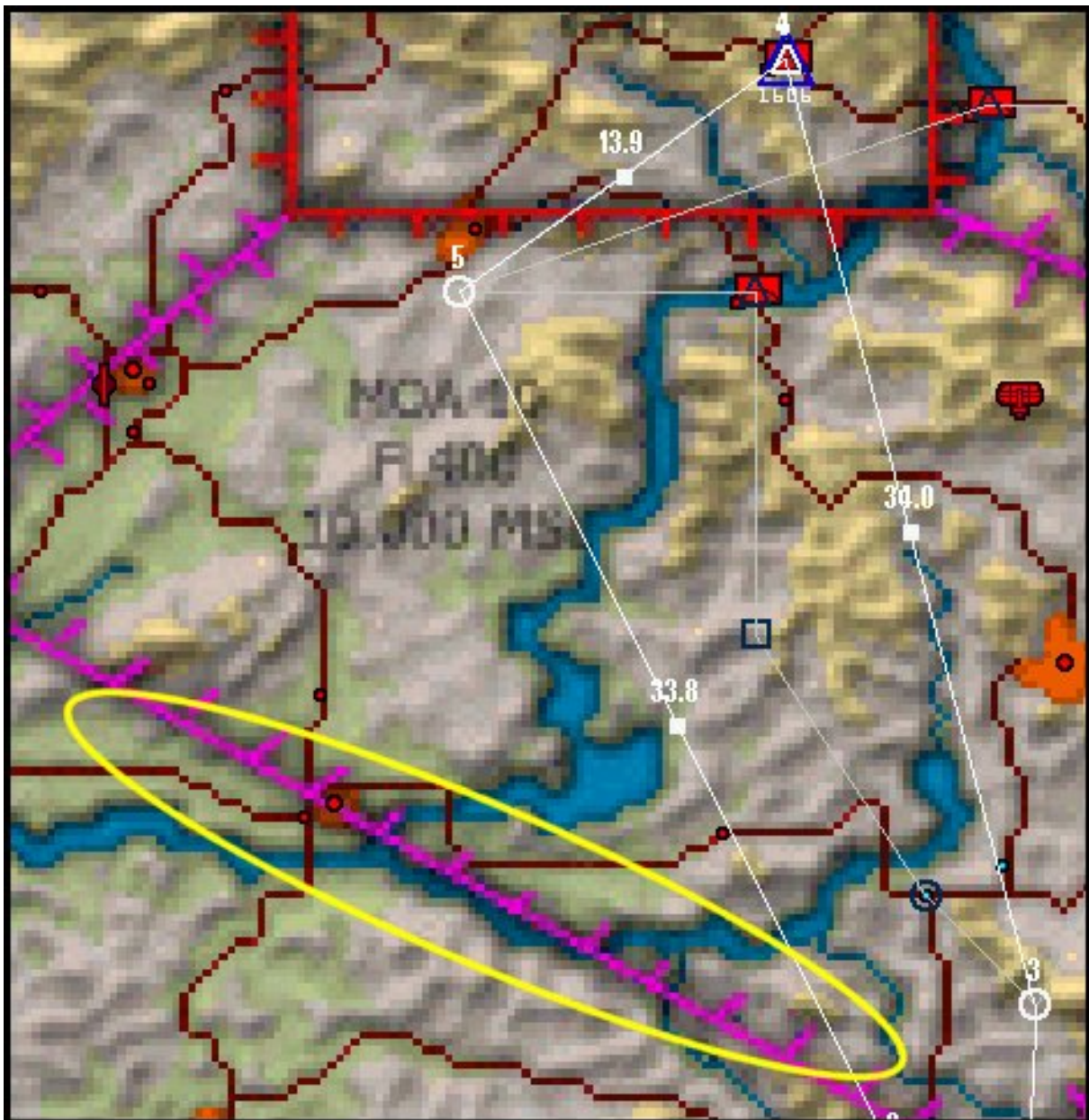
**Enemy Assets:** Known SAM and AAA sites are as displayed in this image:

Enemy CAP flights, presumably consisting of MiG-21, have recently been spotted in the area as displayed in this image:



**Friendly Support:** An E-3A AWACS is flying ELINT off the South-East coast.

**Weather:** Early morning mist to 3,000 feet ASL, with a density of 90-100 percent is expected. This is going to make visual identification of ground targets very difficult, and will possibly nullify the use of certain guided munitions.

**Home Plate:** Pusan Airbase, TACAN channel 087X

**Divert Field:** Pohang Airbase, TACAN channel 072X

**Notes:** Mission Success and Partial Success for all three flights is wholly dependant on the status of the two bridges only. Certainly both Strike flights, and possibly all three flights, will be required to complete their assigned tasks for the whole mission to be a success.
