## BACKGROUND

South Korea has all but been overrun by the invading DPRK. However, the limited US and ROK Forces in theatre at the time of the assault held the Pusan perimeter, and since reinforcements have arrived from the USA, the DPRK advance has steadily been slowed. The liberation of South Korea will begin very soon.

## CURRENT SITUATION

Currently, the DPRK still have at their disposal a varied array of combat aircraft, including limited numbers of MiG-23s and MiG-27s, as well as vast numbers of MiG-17s and MiG-21s. Known SAM systems available to them include SA-2, SA-4, SA-5 and SA-6 types, but this list is far from exhaustive. Numerous KS-12/KS-19 AAA equipped battalions have also been identified.

This mornings' mission calls for a strike against the Daechi Ri Bridge. DPRK forces, the 1576th Tank Battalion, have been spotted in the vicinity and are believed to be heading for the Namhae Chemical plant. As this installation has been used for "experimental" purposes recently, its absolutely vital we prevent the enemy from capturing this laboratory complex.

## MISSION DETAILS

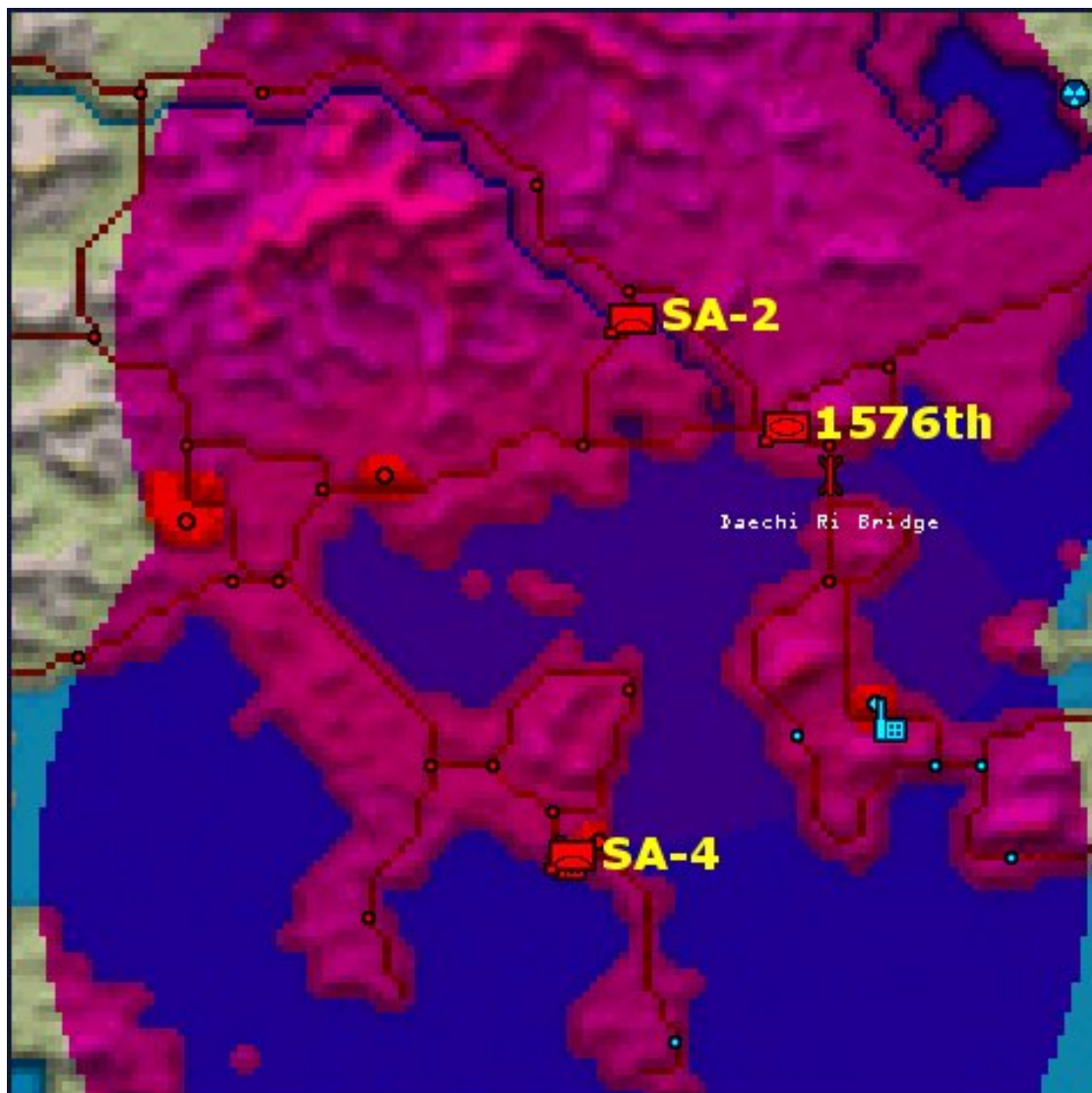
**Target:** As we cannot afford to destroy the Namhae Chemical Plant, it has been decided we will run a strike against the Daechi Ri Bridge, thus cutting off the only land-based route to it. It's hoped the DPRK will turn their attentions elsewhere as a result of the Namhae Chemical Plant proving difficult to reach by sea.

**Weather:** The weather currently is very poor, and it's not expected to clear up any time soon. High winds are currently being experienced along the coastal area, currently 266 degrees at 21 knots. Cumulus clouds overcast at 5,000 feet ceiling, ranging from 2,000 to 15,000 feet in thickness, resulting in heavy precipitation. Furthermore, thick mist at 90-95 percent to approximately 1,200 feet ASL will mean the poor weather may well be your biggest enemy in this mission.

Ordinarily, we would consider scrubbing all flights on such a day, but the importance of the Namhae Chemical Plant means we cannot wait for a break in the weather, and we have no option but to fly.

*Hint: If you use Tom's HiTiles, consider loading up the winter season for this one.*

**Enemy:** Known SAM and AAA sites are as displayed in this image:

**Friendly Support:** An E-3A AWACS is flying ELINT off the South-East coast. Expect other flights out of both home plates if necessary.
