BACKGROUND

An uneasy peace has existed for a number of months now between the North and South Koreans. Despite repeated claims to the contrary, the North has been continuing to strengthen its Armed Forces, its Air Force in particular. Intelligence suggests they have several squads of MiG-29A and other capable types deployed in close proximity to the DMZ. Similarly, several reports of sightings of modern Russian-built SAM systems have been made also, and it's now believed the DPRK have at least two of the SA-10 type and *at least* six each of the SA-4 and SA-6 types deployed also. This information has yet to be confirmed however.

CURRENT SITUATION

The positive identification of a number of MiG-29S airframes was made yesterday evening when they were seen to land at Wonsan Airbase. This would also account for the heavy increase of transport traffic reported in and around the airbase also. As you are well aware, this type presents a real step-up in capability available to the DPRK. Command has decided to try to negate the threat by crippling their ability, albeit temporarily, to use the MiGs by destroying the Ammo Dumps and Fuel Storage at Wonsan. Due to the fragile nature of the Peace, it has been decided US Forces in South Korea will undertake this strike mission – we're only going to deny all knowledge when the shit hits the fan at the United Nations anyway!


MISSION DETAILS

Target: The targets are the Ammo Dumps and Fuel Storage at Wonsan Airbase, and can be seen in the following image:



For the mission to be considered a success, both Ammo dumps and all three Fuel Storage tanks are to be destroyed. A partial success will be recorded if the Ammo Dumps are destroyed. If both Ammo Dumps are not destroyed then the mission will be a failure.

Enemy Assets: Known SAM and AAA sites are as displayed in the following image:



Be aware also of the frigates off the coast at Wonsan. They can pose a real threat if you get too close.

Known enemy air assets can be fully assessed in the on-line "Order of Battle" display as usual.

Friendly Support: An E-3A AWACS is flying ELINT over Choongwong.

Weather: Scattered clouds at 8,000 feet over the entire Korean Peninsula. Visibility is excellent, and in excess of 50 miles.

Home Plate: Seoul Airbase, TACAN channel 046X. Active runway 18

Divert Field: Mandumi Airfield, TACAN channel 083X. Active runway 20
