BACKGROUND

As part of the huge annual "Red Flag" exercise, the 185th has finally taken a part of this annual NATO meeting.

However, Italy has offered its airspace for the exercise to be held at this time as this is the first time to take place in the Balkans area.

CURRENT SITUATION

First day of Red Flag is a busy day. Strategic planners has issued a series of missions to try and destroy as much assets as possible for the Red side.

The 185th is tasked to take out many targets within the same vicinity which obviously requires a good SA and co-operation between the flights while listening carefully to their Airborne controllers.

MISSION DETAILS

Weather –

- b. Wind: 180 deg @ 5 kts
- Temp: 20 deg c
- Clouds: Broken @ 7,000ft MSL
- Visibility: 5nm, Good

Enemy – The Enemy has lots of High-Tech machines. This is including advanced weapons. Ground defences are many, including SA-10, SA-6, SA-4, SA-3 and SA-2, not mentioning Manpads and IR SAMs

Enemy has multiple SU-30MKK squadrons which are equipped with the most advanced weapons produced for that type. Greece also has an active F-16-52+ on duty.

Enemy's Naval forces have already captured some of the west side shores which are believed to be a high threat.

Friendly – This is a 185th task alone for the time being while we are being supported by AWACS and JSTARS and as well as Tanker support provided by the KC-135.

Mission – The 185th should destroy their assigned targets below in the "Target" section.

Targets

Cowboy1: Two Depots, and the two buildings.



Lobo1: Two fuel tanks, Control Tower and the Radar at **Capodichino AB.**



Python1: Grazzanise AB to 0% operational. (By Destroying Runway)

ROE - Confirm with AWACS and/or Flight lead as required before engaging.

Ordinance - Free
