BACKGROUND

The bad dudes have taken all of the theatre except a small area around Pusan and Japan. The 185th is admirably and convincingly holding back the bad dudes and in the very near future we will be attempting a push forward and start to make some gains.

CURRENT SITUATION

We have just got a sniff down the wind that the bad dudes have acquired a large quantity of free fall bombs, probably with the aim of carpet bombing (a tactic they have been using a lot) the proverbial out of what remains 185th territory and putting the war to a swift end. We know that most of these bombs have been delivered to Kwangju airbase in the south west, where there are already a number of attack aircraft and we expect a new bomber squadron to arrive very soon for maximum effect. The exact details of the bombs are sketchy at best, but we have been advised that there is a possibility,

given the history of the current bad dude regime, that there may well be a small number of bombs with a nuclear capability, although we dont know if this is true or, if it is true, which ammo dump they are being held in.

MISSION DETAILS

This mission has been devised for maximum success. We should have a pilot and weapon surplus in case of any problems encountered a long the way.

The task for escort is very clear, protect all 5 friendly planes (Cowboy and Raven) from enemy a-a attack. If Raven is lost it is a mission fail. If 1 aircraft is lost from Cowboy to a-a attack it is a partial success. If 2 or more aircraft are lost from Cowboy to a-a attack it is a mission fail.

The task for strike is to destroy all 5 ammo dumps at the target site. A partial success can only be achieved if 4 of the 5 ammo dumps are destroyed.

Weather – Wind: 17kts @ 180°

Cloud: Overcast with cloud at 6000ft

Visibility: 14nm Excellent

Temp: 9°C

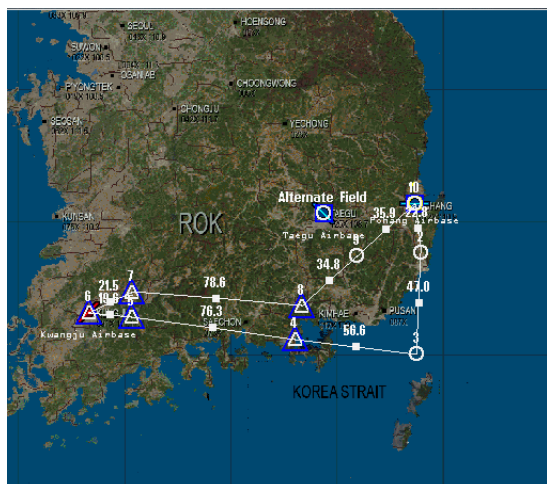
Enemy –

See the order of battle for a full list of enemy aircraft involved, which include Mig 21, 23, 29 and II28s.

Expect the base to be well defended from air and ground units. We are particularly worried about the enemy ground units in the vicinity since there are a number of very high values assets in the area including Kwangju chemical plant and Kwangju power plant, although we do not know of the exact standard or position of infra-red SAMs, if any. There is a large threat circle over the target but we have been unable to determine a type as yet. There are expected to be a number of undiscovered SAM unit's enroute so keep an eye on your RWR, particularly for mobile SAM units.

Friendly – There is a tanker and AWACS around the Pusan area, covered by a patriot and hawk system. The home plate is also defended by a patriot system. The ECM flight will meet you at stpt 3 and fly along your route until stpt 8. It will jam all the way, and has a time on station between stpts 6 & 7 of five minutes so you will need to have your attack finished in that time, it should be ample time.

Target – All 5 ammo dumps need to be destroyed, there are 3 together and the other 2 are spread apart:



Route – Both human flights currently have the same number and organisation of stpts. Both human flights will be taking off from Kadena airbase and it is advised that you try and stay as close to the EF-111 as possible for ultimate protection from radar SAMs.
