Background

Chemical weapons manufacturing have been confirmed by intel at the Sunch'on Nitrolime Fertilizer Factory and #1 Synth Fibre Factory. Before any of these weapons can be distributed an immediate Deep Strike has been authorised using 7 available B-1B bombers.

The bombers are taxiing and will soon be ready for take off.

F16s of 185th have just escaped being shot down by Mig 21's carrying rear aspect heat seeking missiles, as they rtb'd, winchester following a previous mission. The pilots used a defensive bracket manoeuvre to get to friendly air space. This has now split the squadron between Mandumi and Kimpo Airbases.

The jets have been re-fuelled and armed with AIM 9P sidewinders (the only available missiles currently at these bases). Fortunately AGM88's are plentiful and have been loaded. There's no time for resting as 185th must immediately scramble and provide a SEAD Escort for the bombers and ensure their safe return.

We know the Migs are out there and we know all enemy AC only carry rear aspect heat seekers.

Mission

Protect the B1-B's from all threats. The bombers will be flying a straight in approach at high level.

Mission Success Criteria

Cowboy 1 & Falcon 1 – No losses to any of the B-1Bs due to radar guided SAMs or AA engagements.

Partial success Criteria

Cowboy 1 & Falcon 1 - Maximum of 2 bomber losses due to radar guided SAMs or AA engagements.

Take OFF

B-1Bs take off from Suwon & Seoul Airbases.

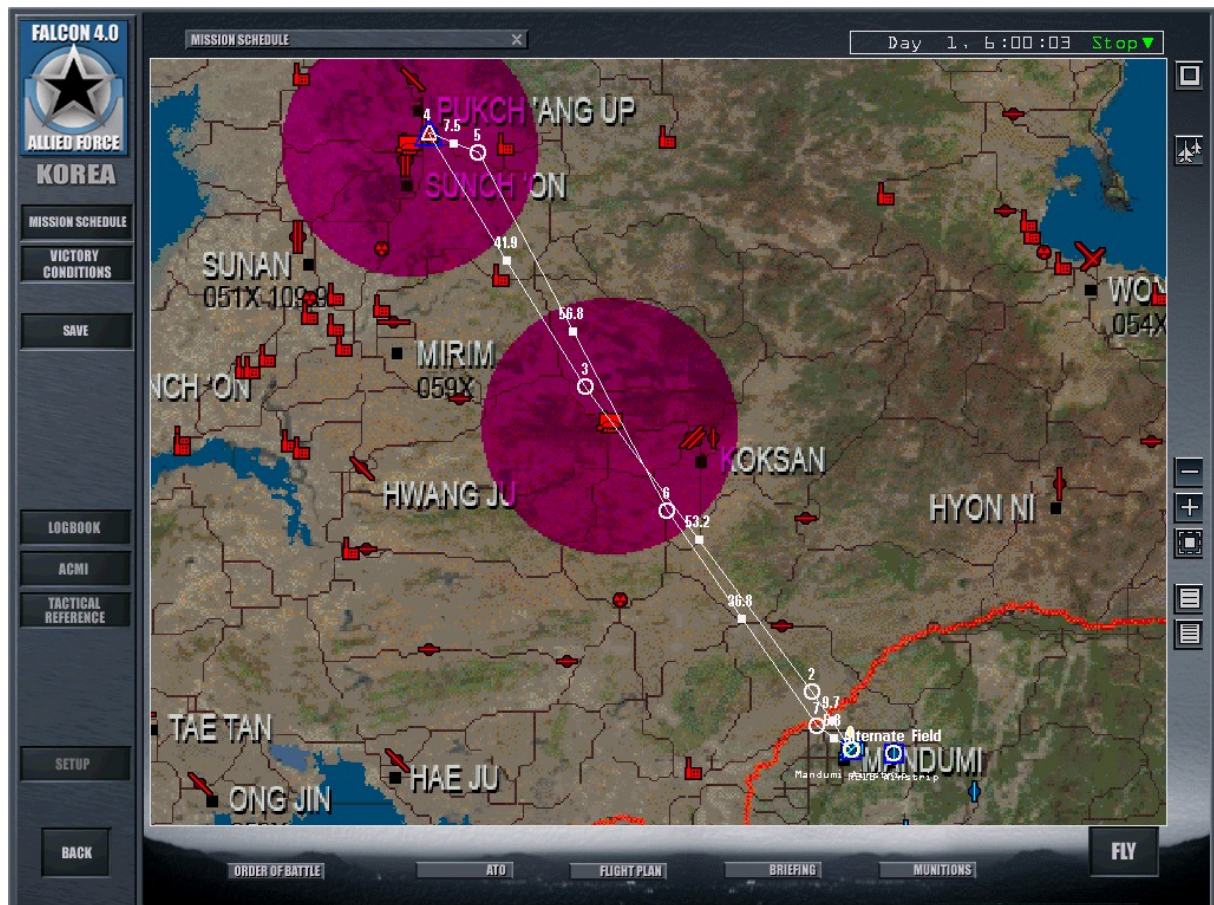
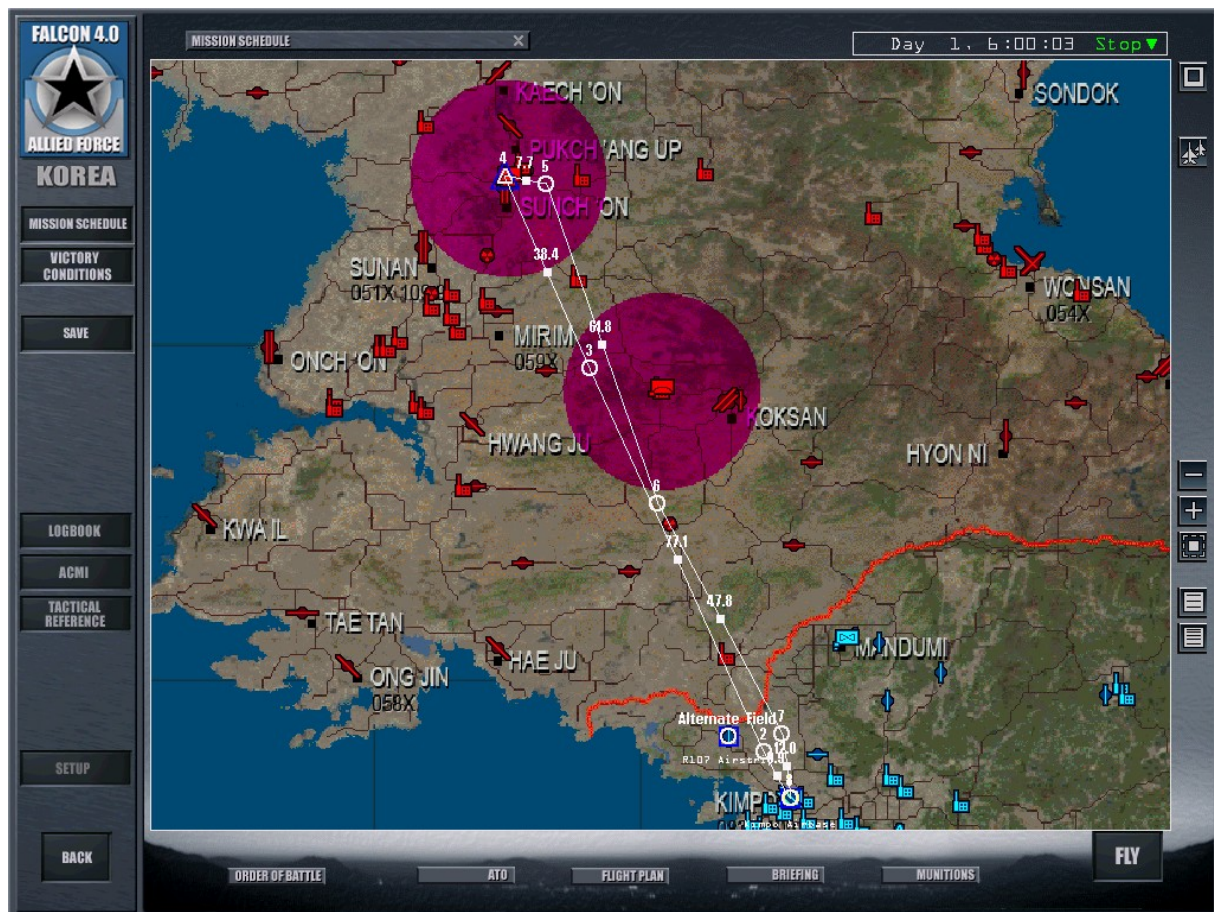
Cowboy 1 take off from Kimpo AB.
Falcon 1 take off from Mandumi AB.

Weapons

AA loadouts are fixed (Only AIM 9P available).

AG loadouts are free (AGM 88 is advised).

The flight plan is free for Cowboy & Falcon flights only.



Enemy

SA2 are known threats on route and expect some type of mobile radar SAM systems to be active. AAA is not a concern.
