## BACKGROUND

Its the 1st day of the war and so far we havent quite had the impact that we thought we would. 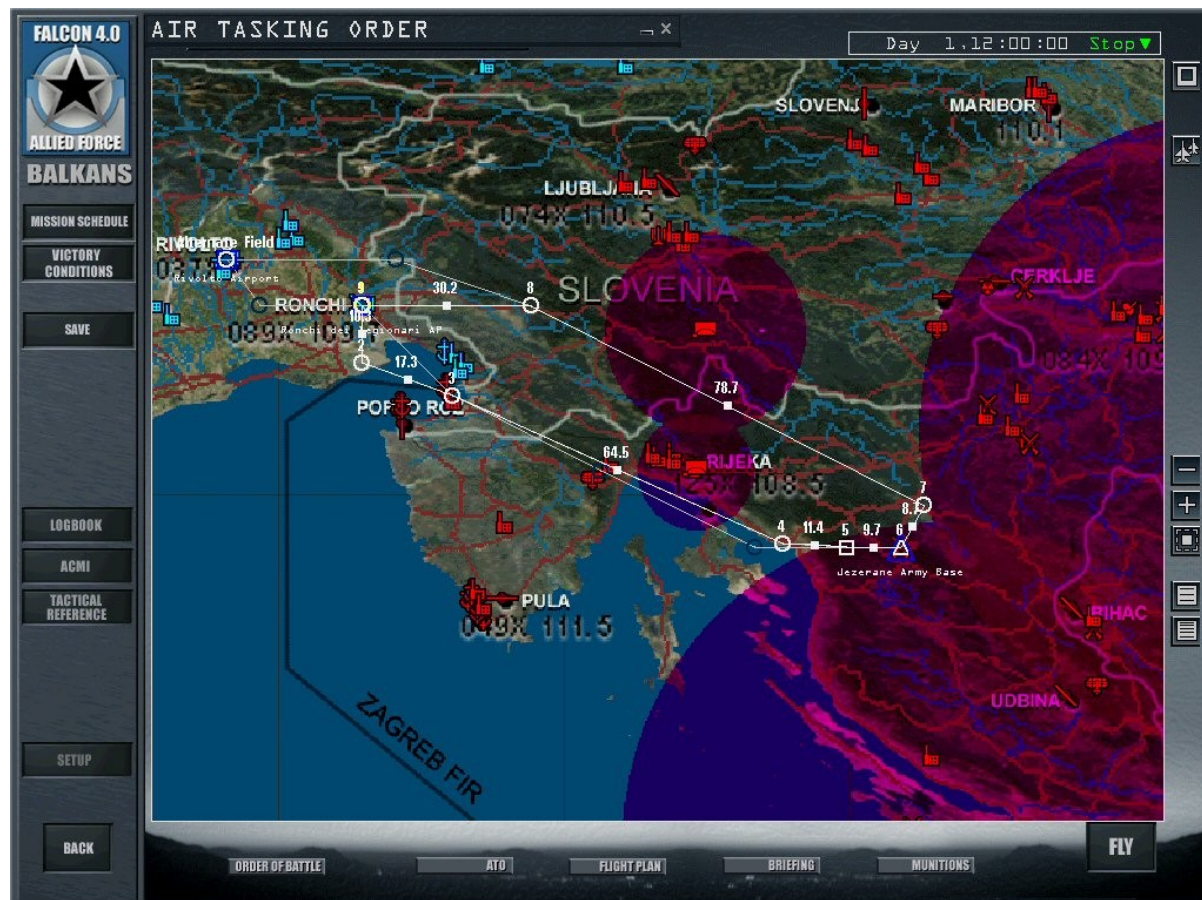

As mentioned already their weapons are not believed to be better than ours, they are also believed to have rear aspect IR missiles only.

There are believed to be at least 4 SAM units, because of the lack of support aircraft there is a great amount of fog of war so we expect multiple mobile SAMs, along with the various AAA battalions all over the battlefield, protecting their most important assets. It is an army base so don't be surprised if there is some sort of army unit stopping there for a spot of lunch. We can't specify what unit could be there as the situation is very fluid. There may/may not be IR SAMs, the advice is to be cautious.

Ordinance –

Fury1: 6x AIM-9P, 2x 370 Gallon wing tanks and 1x ALQ-131. Any of these may be removed, but not replaced by something else.

Cowboy1: 4x AIM-9P (may be removed but not replaced by something else) 2x MK-84 and 2x 370 Gallons (the 4 inner pylons may be removed and replaced by any other variant of dumb bomb - BSUs, MKs, CBUs and BLUs or just left empty).
