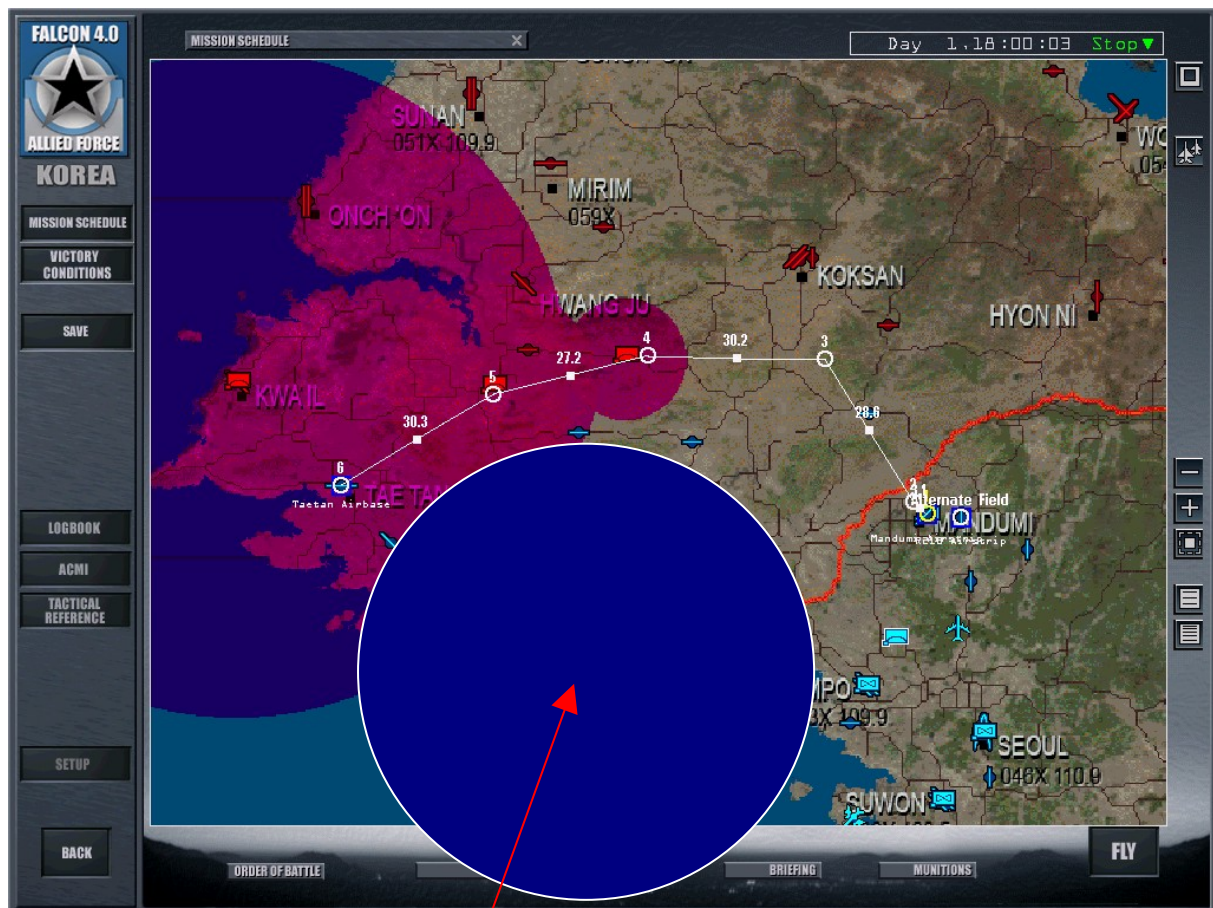

Background

Allied Forces have successfully pushed North Westerly and taken over enemy positions and runways. Most of the runways are out of action from 185th bombing campaigns but Taetan AB only took light damage and has been repaired by our Engineers. It is vital that we re-supply our front line troops who will struggle to hold their positions, as the enemy re-groups, ready for a massive counter attack to regain its land. A carrier group has been spotted off the West Coast, likely to be part of a plan to attack our forces from the West and the North East simultaneously.

4 C-130H transports have been loaded up with vital supplies and require escort to Taetan Airbase until they have safely landed to deliver the goods. The carrier group is dangerously close, so the Hercules route has been pushed to the North, the safer option, providing the 185th do their job to protect them.

Enemy

SA2/SA3 & SA10 are known threats to the North with potential for SA6. The current position of the enemy carrier poses a deadly threat from SA-N-6 (Naval SA10) – “the silent killer”!

Details of Hostile AC and locations are available in the Order of Battle at Mission planning and include SU33 Sea Flankers, Mig 29's and Mig 21's & 27's.

All Loadouts are fixed due to short supplies – Fuel is plentiful so not limited.

Steerpoints are Free for Human Flights.

Falcon1 & Cowboy1 are flying from Kimpo Airbase.

Note* - it is highly recommended to stick close to the set waypoints, in fact potentially suicidal to change them – The SA-N-6 takes no prisoners - you have been warned!

The C130s route must not be changed -They are flying from Mandumi and climb to >A15 to avoid the potential threat from small arms fire and shoulder launched IR SAMs.
