BACKGROUND

Intelligence reports from our spies within the DPRK, backed up by confirmed sightings by an Elite Recon Squad, have confirmed the development of a new experimental OSA2-class ship is currently undergoing tests in a large lake to the north of the town of Oro-up. It is believed this new vessel has vastly improved capabilities compared to the current model, including the ability to carry the SA-N-7 (navalised SA-11) SAM system. If these beliefs hold true, the updated OSA2 could prove to represent a significant threat to Allied shipping and their escorting/patrolling flights in the East Sea.

MISSION

Your squadron has been tasked to fly a strike mission to not only destroy the two vehicles currently being tested in the lake, but also to strike the Underground Factory to halt test and production of further similar vessels.

MISSION SUCCESS CRITERIA

- Cowboy flight : Destroy both OSA2-class vessels.
- Falcon flight : Destroy the Underground Factory and at least one bunker.
- Fury flight : Ensure no losses to both strike flights.

MISSION PARTIAL SUCCESS CRITERIA

- Cowboy flight : Destroy at least one of the OSA2-class vessels (see Image 1).
- Falcon flight : Destroy the Underground Factory or at least one bunker (see Image 2).
- Fury flight : Ensure no more than 50 percent losses to both strike flights.

For Fury escort flight, a maximum of one loss to each flight will result in a partial success. If both Cowboy planes are lost while both Falcon survive or vice versa, this will be counted as **Mission Failure**. At least one airframe from each side must return home to qualify for a partial success. See **Table 1 (bottom of briefing) for full parameters**.

FLIGHT PARAMETERS

Home Plate : Kangnung Airbase, TACAN 056X.

Alternate : Seosan Airbase, TACAN 083X

Weapons : Loadouts are free, you may select any and all weapons you feel your package will require to ensure you succeed in your mission.

Flightplan : The flightplan is free, you may alter it to suit accordingly (see Image 3 for Locations).

Weather : Clear, light winds, 183 degrees at 5 knots.
Medium morning mist to 2,500 feet approx.

FRIENDLY SUPPORT

An E-8 JSTARS is on station south of Seoul to provide ELINT.
No AWACS is available!
HAWK SAM installations at Kimpo and Mandumi Airbases.

ENEMY INTEL

Fixed SA-2 installations and SA-5 installations can also be confirmed in the Online Planner.
SA-6 battalions are known to be operating in the arena, current locations are unknown.
All DPRK squadrons can also be confirmed in the Online Planner.

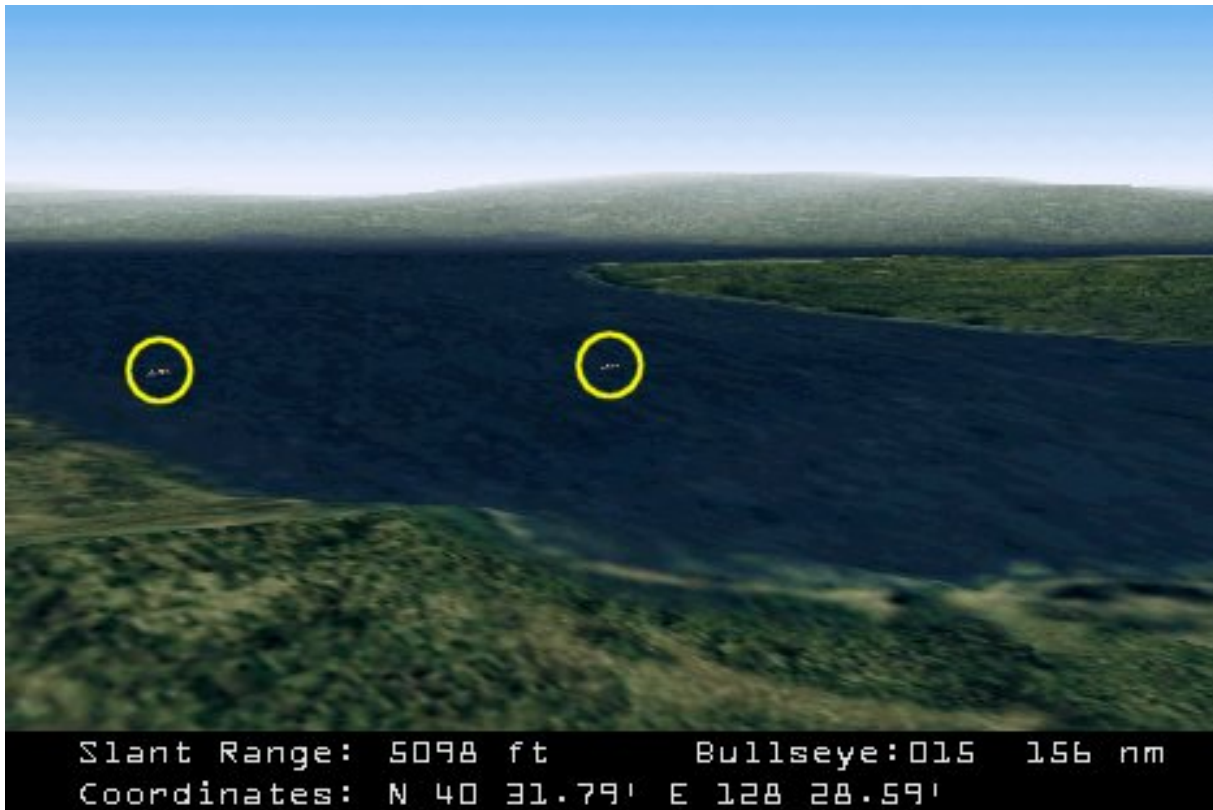


Image 2 – Recon photo of Underground Factory and Bunkers.

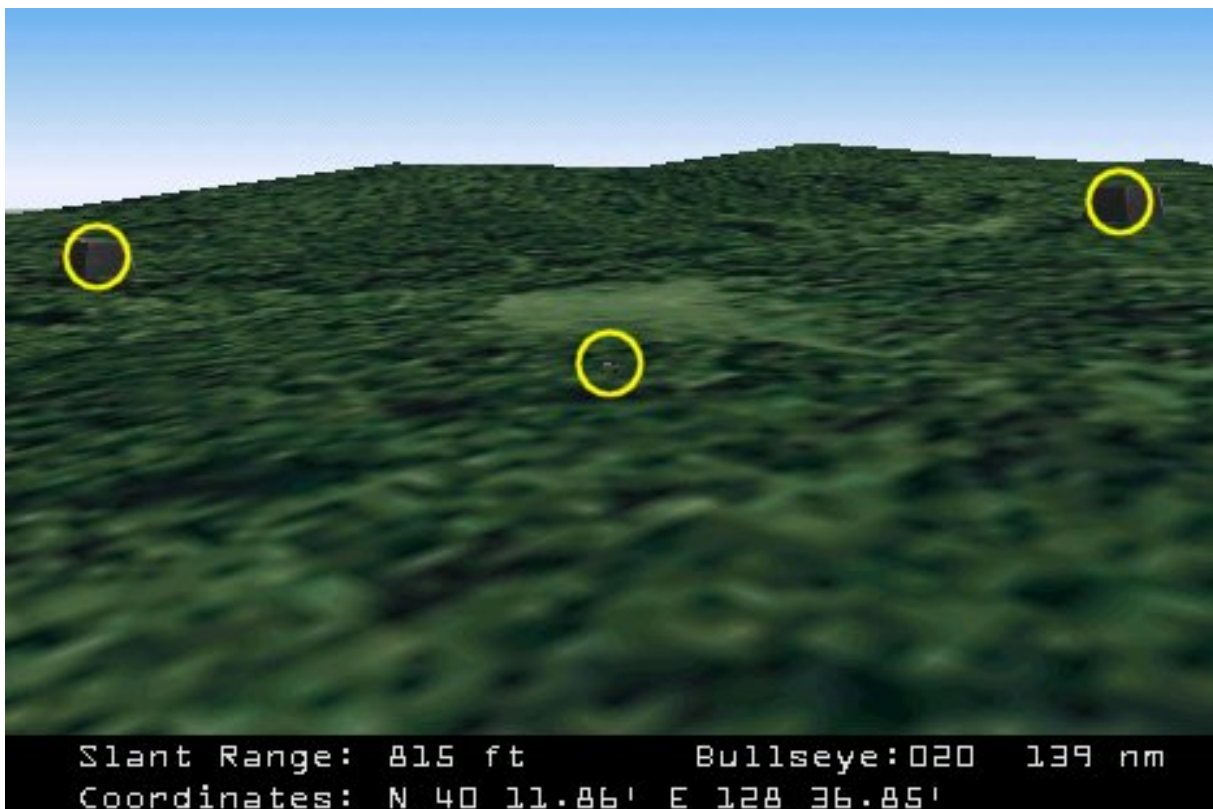


Image 3 – Overview map of Target Locations

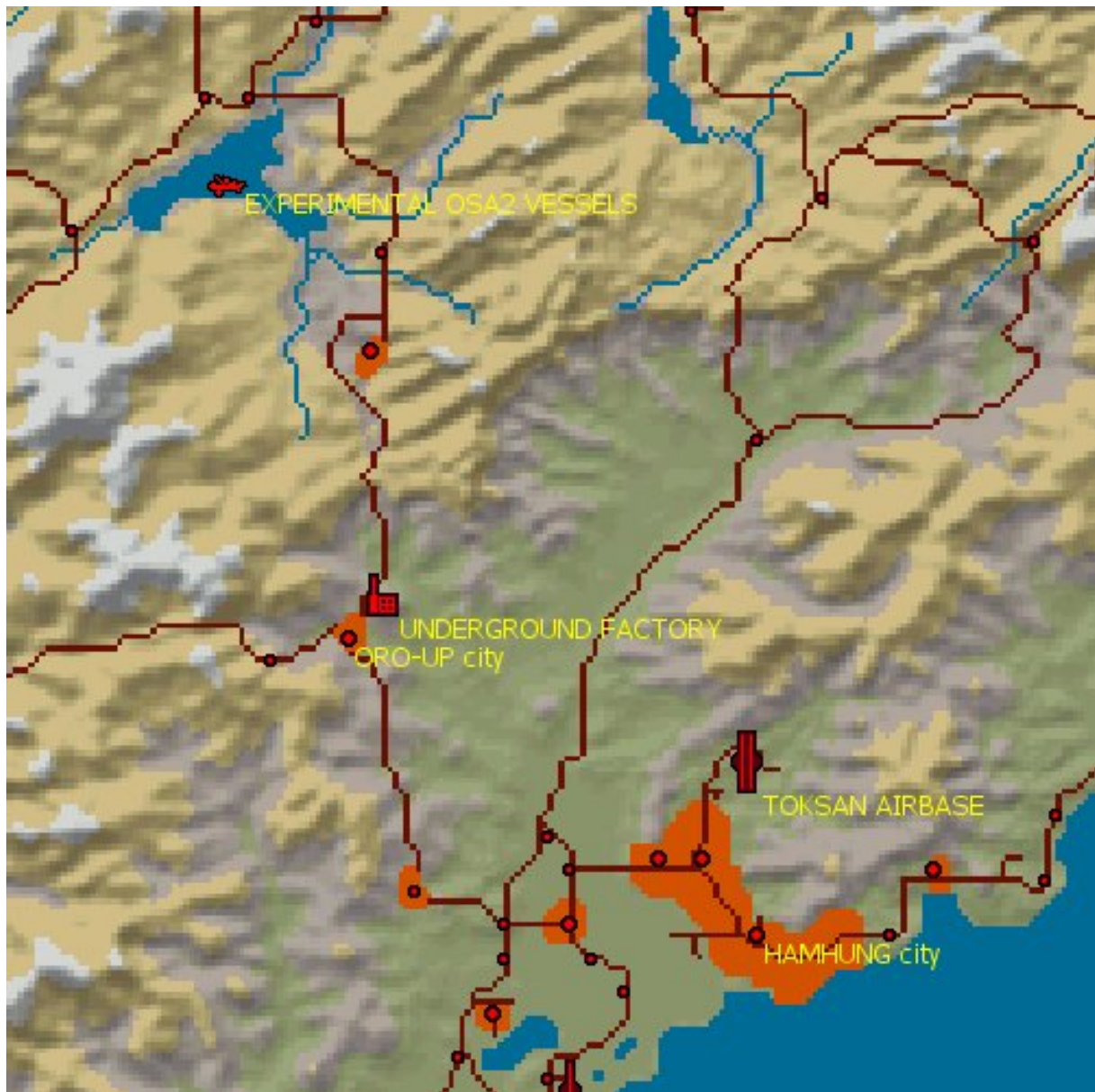
