BACKGROUND

Mitrovica is still a hotspot between the various Balkan factions with each party wanting the town in their hands.

CURRENT SITUATION

Intel reports several paramilitary sniper units on the way to Mitrovica, with the probable intent of engaging targets indiscriminantly.

MISSION DETAILS

The UN and NATO have agreed to destroy these sniper units and the training camp they deployed from. The 185th has been tasked with the mission and have been recalled at short notice from some well earned rest (after a couple of tough missions in Korea). Departures will therefore be from several airbases in Albania.

Target

Primary: Destroy at least 3 of the 4 Sniper Battalions (3889th, 3890th, 3891st & 3892nd) between Stp 5 and 6 as they move towards Mitrovica. Each battalion consists of 2 men, a sniper and a gunner. The battalions are hard to spot so you may wish to use padlock.

Secondary: Destroy the 'Novi Pazar Army Camp' at Stp 7 where these Sniper Battalions have been trained. Be aware it is heavily protected by air defenses.

Enemy

G/T: Several SAM systems are covering the area. Notably an SA5 has been identified by INTEL. AAA, SA6 and SA3 been also been reported, but locations are unknown.

DO NOT ENGAGE ANY SA4 IN FYROM AIRSPACE!!(SEE ROE)

A/T: check order of battle!!

Friendly

An E-2C Hawkeye AWACS and E-8C Sentry are on station. EA-6B's are jamming enemy frequencies around the Southern SA5, so remember, FRIENDLIES IN THE AREA. The Prowlers are taking off from a friendly carrier group in the Adriatic, some 40nm off the coast.

Weather / Take Off **IMPORTANT!!**

Home plate: Wind 180°@5knts, Clouds clear, Angles 30-36 contrails, visibility is excellent (14nm) at altitude but there is a fog layer up to around 3000ft. Note the weather is expected to deteriorate during the morning.

Take-off's: Fury1 Rinas airbase 0935, Falcon1 Shkoder airbase 0936, Cowboy1 **Kukes** airbase 0943 (**see special departure procedures under roe**)

Target area: Exact weather conditions between Stp 5 & Stp 6 are unknown but it is unlikely to be any better than at home plate. **Attention!!** at Stp 7 (Army base) there is likely to be dense clouds. Think carefully about weapons choice.

Route

Although route is free, we recommend following the original one roughly. It gives you the best chance to find and destroy your target.

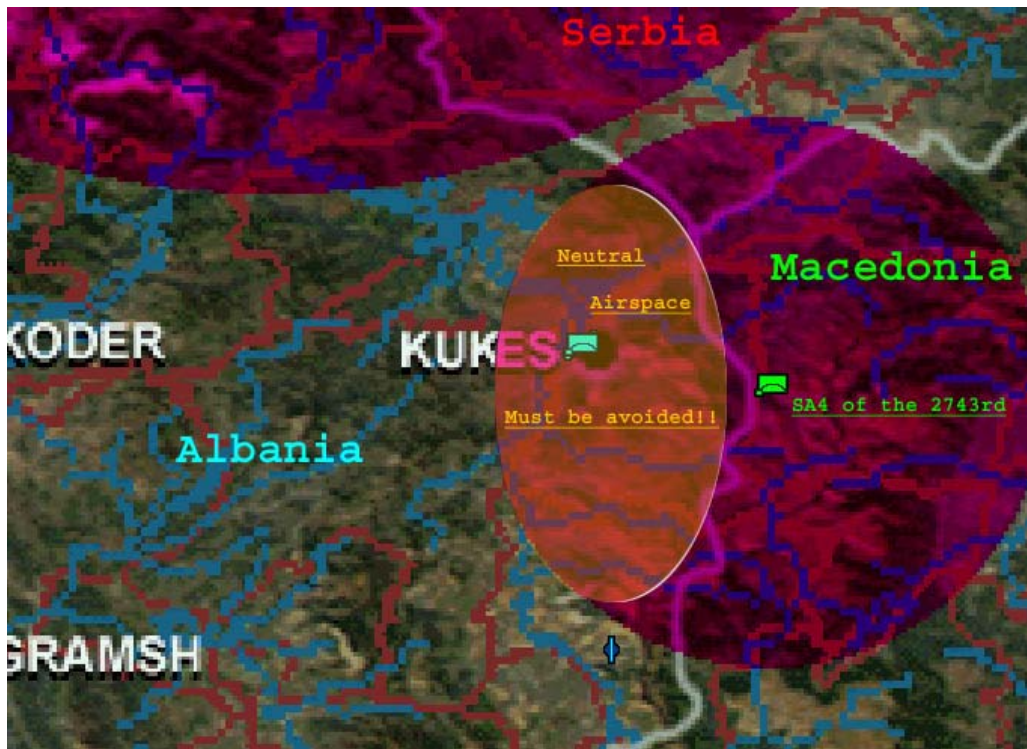
ROE

Entering FYROM or neutral airspace¹ must be avoided at ALL TIMES

Note there is a FYROM SA4 battalion (2743rd) covering the neutral airspace above Kukes airspace.

If the FYROM SA4 (2743rd) FIRES on an aircraft flown by a member of the 185th or a member of the 185th crosses the FRYOM border, the mission is FAILED!!

(Note this criteria does not apply to AI controlled aircraft)

¹ Neutral airspace is internationally agreed airspace that no aircraft will enter. The neutral airspace is shown in the diagram above and starts from 4000ft agl and extends up to 70,000 AMSL. When you depart from Kukes stay low until you have left the neutral zone.
