BACKGROUND

Russia has offered support to North Korea, probably preparing for a large scale attack on South Korea where USAF is stationed. North Korea has always shown interest on occupying the missing part of Korea, which is the South.

The US never left South Korea and it remains as an important and strategic spot in East Asia.

CURRENT SITUATION

Looks like Russia is strongly supporting North Korea, and its offering every available unit in the airforce to support that assumed attack alongside its Navy. A US spy satellite has spotted a Russian Aircraft carrier in the East sea, but they didn't exactly confirm its position as its moving in the east sea, and we have no available spy satellites covering this part of the East Sea.

Accordingly, the USAF has issued a classified order to the 185th stating that this aircraft carrier is to be destroyed around 17:30:00 Zulu.

This is the first time for the 185th to attack a Russian Aircraft carrier, thus we need to be careful in this type of missions.

MISSION DETAILS

Weather –

- a. Wind: 106 deg @ 12kts
- b. Temp: 31 deg C
- c. Overcast @ 5,000 ft MSL base.
- d. Con Layer: 30,000 ft MSL
- e. Visibility 3nm, Good
- f. Expect some fogs.

Enemy – The enemy has been equipped with High-Tech weapons which pose a real threat to our forces in the region.

Intel suggests that DRPK's have Mig-21Mbis, Mig-29 with different variants including the A/S/SM version alongside the new advanced SU-30MKK and Mig-31's and 33's.

Intel advises us to be careful with any of those threats as they are capable of carrying Long-Range missiles such as the R-77 and R-33 Air-to-Air missiles.

Ground/Naval threats are many, including SA-2/3/4/6 and most importantly the SA-10 and SA-N-6 which is the naval version of the SA-10, alongside some other weapons used on other ships within the vicinity of target area. Adding to that there might be some IR missiles and AAA.

Enemy expected to be ready to scramble at any minute and we need to be careful with the timings. More time means more risk!

Friendly – There is an AWACS flight controlling the skies for us. Nothing else.

Mission –

Cowboy1 Flight: Cowboy1 flight is the core of this mission and should be protected at all costs, their mission is to destroy the Aircraft Carrier at or around target site and return home immediately after sinking this Kuznetsov Aircraft Carrier with no losses to their flight.

Falcon1 & Fury1 Flights: Are to protect Cowboy1 flight from any threats they encounter during the flight regardless of being Air-to-Air or Ground-to-Air **EXCEPT** any losses due to Guns/Cannons/AAA or ground launched IR missiles or crashes.

Target – (This is an archive picture of the Russian Aircraft carrier "Kuznetsov".)

Route – Is generally fixed for the Naval Strike flight but free for the other flights.

ROE – You need to be ready for any possible threat. Engage once confirmed hostile by your flight lead and/or AWACS.

Ordnance – Free
