



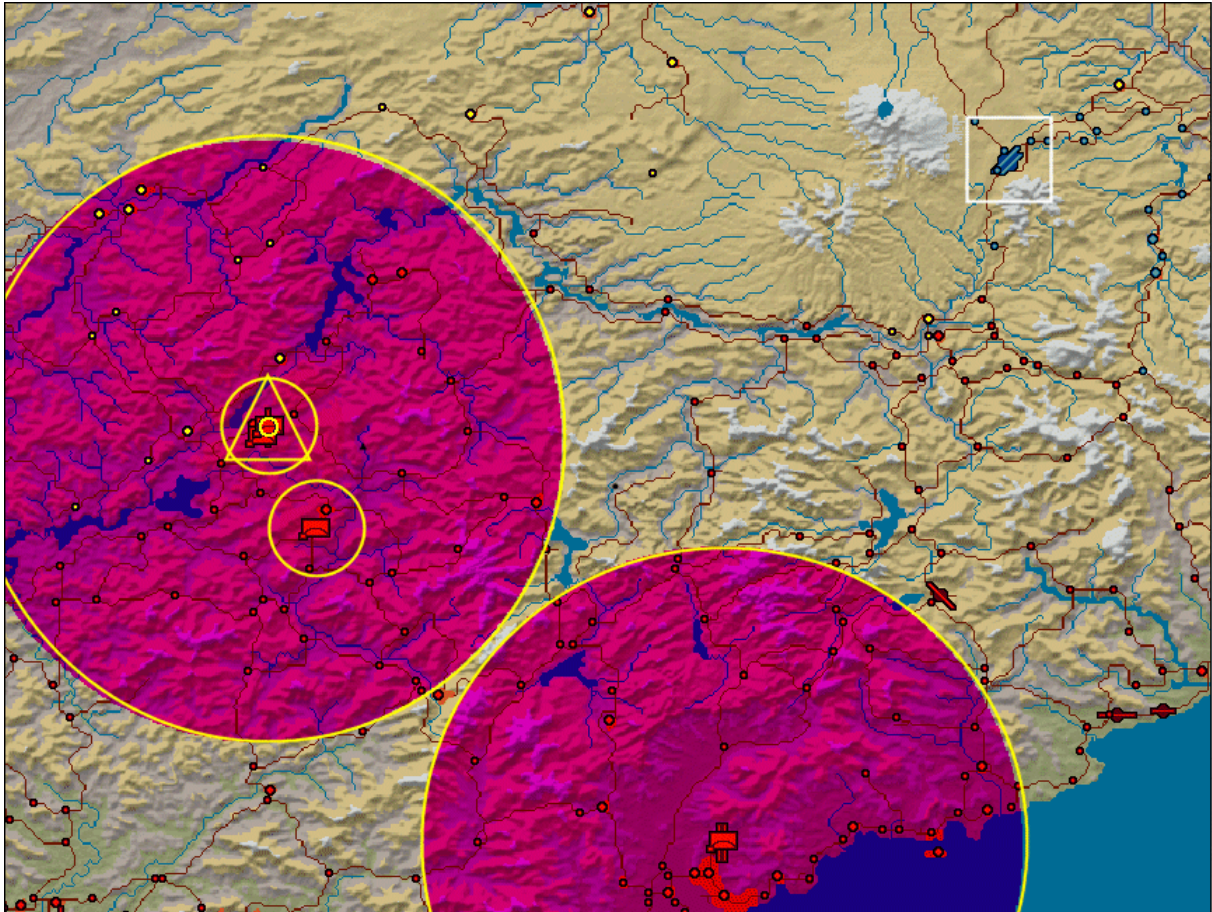

CURRENT SITUATION

Despite the successful strike against the Manp'o Chemical Plant earlier today, word has reached us we were too late in our attack. Unfortunately, a large consignment of the bio-toxin being produced there was shipped by road to nearby Manp'o Airbase and has been loaded onto a waiting IL-76M transport aircraft for onward shipment to an unknown airbase near the Demilitarised Zone, possibly Wonsan or Hyon-ni.

MISSION DETAILS

Immediately, Manp'o Airbase must be disabled to prevent the transport from getting airborne. Furthermore, the IL-76M tasked to ship the bio-toxin has been loaded. The North Koreans, being the sneaky cads that they are, have four IL-76M currently parked at Manp'o, and our spies report significant loads are being placed on each of the four transporters, probably to create some confusion as to which plane is carrying the actual cargo. It has been decided all four will need to be destroyed to ensure the bio-toxin is destroyed.

FRIENDLY SUPPORT

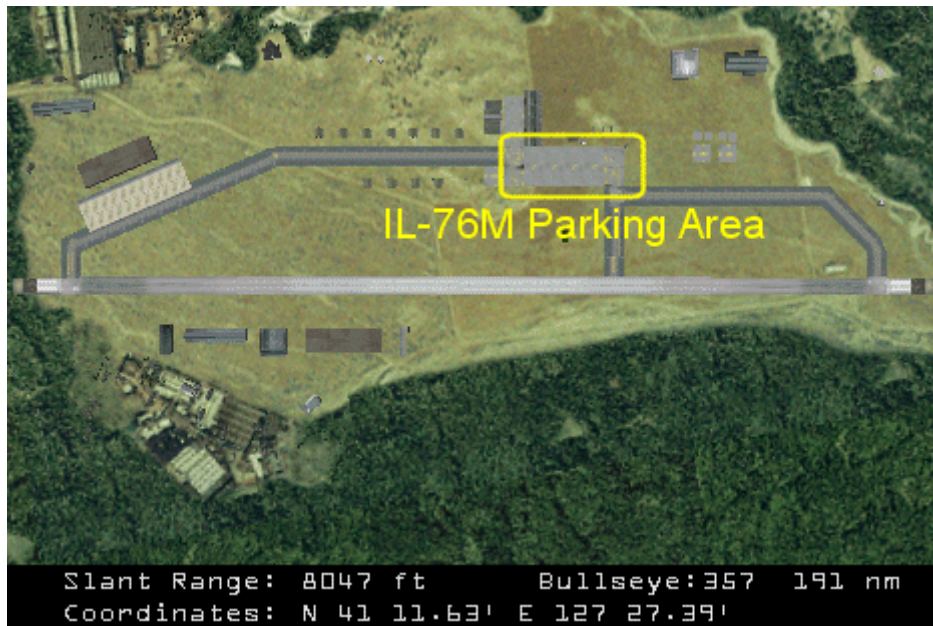
There is an E-3A AWACS on station to provide ELINT regarding enemy aircraft, and a E-8C JSTARS on station to provide ELINT about enemy ground-based units. Both will be airborne and on station approximately 120 minutes before your planned take-off time. CIS Su-27s stationed at Nachodka will be on CAP over Samjiyong-Up.

MISSION DETAILS

Target

The target for this evening is the runway at Manp'o Airbase. Primarily, you need to destroy the runway to prevent the IL-76Ms taking off, but also destroy the aircraft themselves. If you can get there before they take off then destroying them on the ground would be possible, and in many ways preferred to prevent the spread of the bio-toxin, thus making any clean-up operation in the area easier. Be aware though, there's a very good chance the enemy are expecting us. As such, you can expect a step-up in enemy activity as they try to ensure their deadly cargo gets to its destination.

The IL-76Ms are currently parked as marked in the satellite image below:



Weather

Enemy Intel

Currently, it can only be confirmed the DPRK has deployed 2 active Hongqi-10 (Chinese copies of the CIS SA-10) SAM systems in the northern half of the country. The third, at Hwangsuwon, had it tracking and guidance radar vehicle destroyed during todays earlier operation. The areas of coverage can be seen in the above Intel map. Unfortunately for us, the one right on top of the target area, protecting Manp'o Airbase, is still active as we failed to disable it earlier.

We also know the SA-11 battalion near Manp'o has been degraded to some extent. Similar, we know a fully active SA-6 battalion is in the vicinity. It can be taken as read they will have other modern and older systems available to them also.

Hwangsuwon Airbase is home to a squadron of MiG-21Mbis fighters.

Manp'o Airbase is home to a squadron of Su-27 Fighters, A-50 AWACS, and IL-76M Transport aircraft.

Panghyon Airbase is home to a squadron of MiG-29A fighters.

Puk'chang-up Airbase is home to a squadron of MiG-23ML and MiG-21Mbis fighters.

Toksan Airbase is home to a squadron of MiG-29A fighters and MiG-27M attack aircraft.
