BACKGROUND

INTEL assumed few weeks ago that the DPRK will sooner or later start an massive offensive attack against our most powerfull radarstation at Ip'yong-ni in the north-eastern part of South Korea.

MISSION DETAILS

Mission

The 185th has been tasked to push back the incoming SAM battalions and prevent Ip'yong-ni r/s from being captured.

Target



Targets of interests are the Straight Flush radars of the SA6 battalions. See image on the left:

Enemy

The SAM battalions are accompanied by numerous tank battalions, which are NOT TOI! Expect heavy air space support for the battalions such as Mig29's, Mig 23's and Mig21's.

Last but not least, a enemy carrier group has been spotted at BE 049 146, providing air support for their battalions with the power of Su33 Naval Flankers.

Northern part is covered by SA10, which is stationed near Wonsan airbase.

Friendly

AN E-3 AWACS and E-8C Sentry provides you with needed informations.

Also the tanker Camell is cruising around providing you with fuel.

Patriots (Seoul and Techong airbases) and Hawks ADS (Komsu-dong bridge and Ip'yong-ni, do not shoot it!!) may assist you in dragging enemy airtreats into an ambush.

Weather / Take Off

homeplate: wind 180°@5knts, 20°C, Clouds clear, 30'000 MSL base,
visibility is crap (2nm).

target area: a little bit foggy, but no factor.

Route

The given route shall lead you directly into the batallions. Also use GMT radar to pick up movers.

Cowboy1 is taking off from Chongju (042X) at 0848 and Falcon1 Chongwong (005X) from at 0849. Rely point is whiskey two.

Alternate for recovery is ANY friendly airbase or airstrip.

ROE

A/G: don't waste ammo on others than the Straight Flush'es.

A/A: avoid FF!

Watch your steps, don't get into sa6 trap while engaging air-to-air!

Ordonance

We recommend HARM's and/or Mav's/CBU's, whatever you suits.
