### BACKGROUND

As the north and south Korean tensions grow, the current stalemate on the now DPRK territory of the south west coast of Korea is a nervous one. Sources and intellectuals alike believe that moves to push east by the DPRK will come eventually, most believing that it will be sooner rather than later.

### CURRENT SITUATION

As more military is moved onto the east coast, our intelligence operatives have been very busy and under increased threat. Nevertheless, they have discovered that a high level meeting is planned to take place later this morning.

Although a risky move for the DPRK, they are assembling most of their top commanders in what we believe is for a pre-planning meeting for a renewed offensive that would see them invade and capture the remainder of Korea.

#### MISSION DETAILS

#### Weather –

Home Plate:

Enemy – The enemy are fully aware of the value of the personnel they are transporting. Mig 29A, 29S, Mig 21 and Su 27 squadrons are all on alert and will no doubt be active to protect the airlift.

As well as air assets, the DPRK are known to have rolled out SA4, SA5 and SA6 batteries as well as AAA. Whether any mobile pop ups will be around is not known.

Friendly – Apart from your package there will be Chalis 1 AWACs on station by the time you are airborne. They will be accompanied by Bat 1, a two ship of F-14B fighters.

Mission – Your mission is two fold. You must stop the airlift getting to Kangju AB, preferably by destroying the four transport aircraft. Secondly you must destroy the admin building at Kangju AB. This is the place where the meeting is to be held. Other commanders will already be there, along with irreplaceable DPRK intelligence on us. It is imperative this building is destroyed. No escape from the AB must be allowed and to that end the runway must be destroyed.

Route – The route is free though it is suggested that an intercept of the four transport aircraft is considered.

ROE – The only friendlies are those previously briefed. As a state of war exists, you are free to fire on any confirmed targets.

Ordinance – Weapon choice is free. Consideration of the number and type of missiles required to down a transport aircraft is recommended.

Target – The ground targets are both at Kwangju AB.
