BACKGROUND

Wing Commander Vosene is a little unhappy to say the least. He's been playing chess on-line with a Russian lady, who happened to e-mail him one day, and it turns out that she was a spy trying to trick him into revealing military secrets. To think they thought they could trick him that way!

WC Vosene has been informed by his superiors that "...something must be done to counter this threat!"

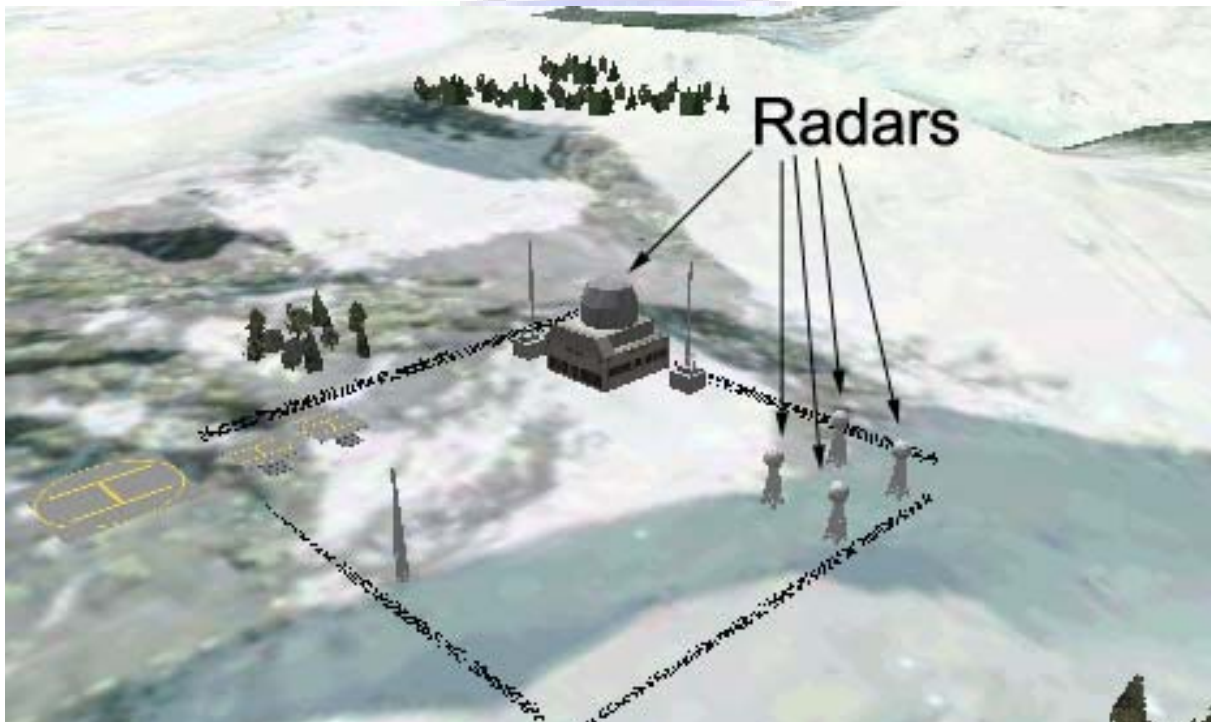
CURRENT SITUATION

While not officially in open conflict with the Balkan states, open aggression is often threatened and it would not be good to make this worse. Tit-for-tat strikes are, however, not unusual.

MISSION DETAILS

Mission – Command has located the listening station as being in the radar station at Sadici. They also know that the information collected by the cell, is currently stored there and has not been transferred to any centres for analysis. This means we have an opportunity to safe guard our secrets, but we have to be quick and quiet.

Target – The Early Warning Radar (EWR) station must be completely flattened to ensure the information is destroyed, with at least the five radars being demolished for any kind of success.



Weather – Weather at home plate is:

Wind: 8kts @ 5°

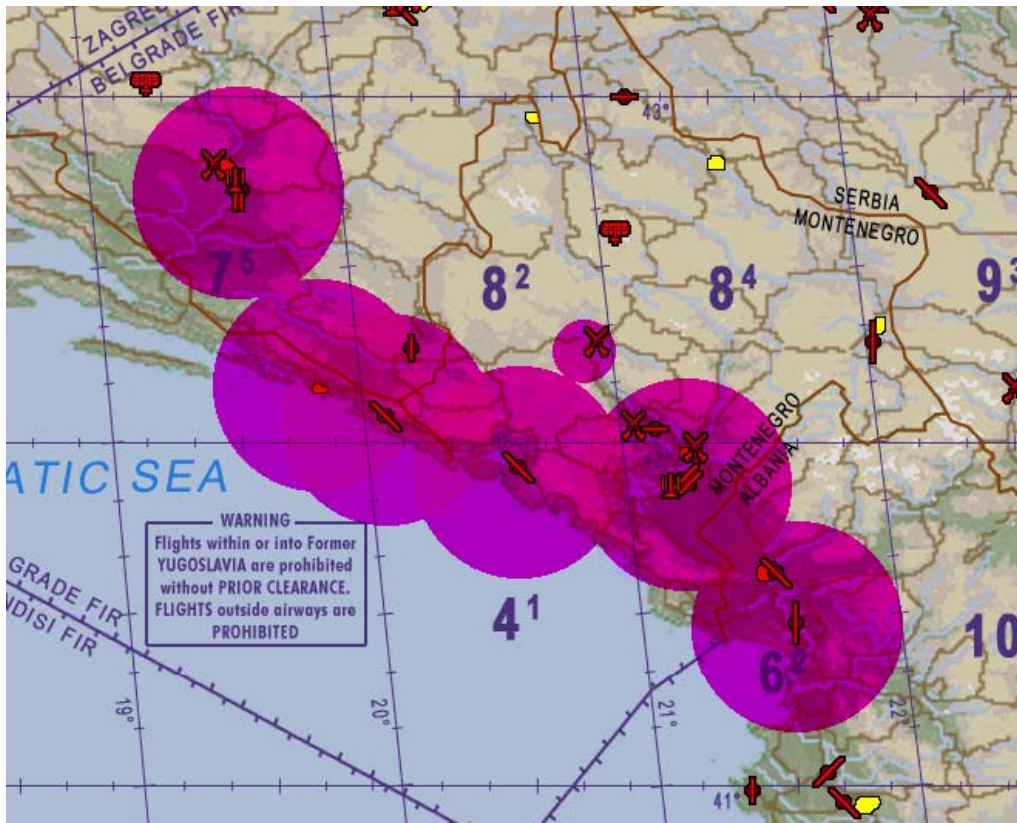
Temperature: 26°C

Con Layer: 30000'

Visibility: Good

At target site expect low cloud covering the mountains, just above the radar site.

Enemy – The enemy has lined the coast with SA-4 battalions. Fortunately we managed to obtain high altitude threat range information for you, although you will be blind on their current locations once you are in the air. Other mobile SAMs are though to be moving within the route area.



Enemy aircraft are in abundance with R-77 capable aircraft known to be on station. Unfortunately we have no idea where these aircraft are based so keep focused and prepare your AA engagement strategy properly before take-off.

Route – The route is fixed to enable good cover for Cowboy from Falcon at an early stage. Low level flying will be required close to the enemy coast to a) avoid radar lock by SA-4s and b) to avoid radar contact from the enemy, which would alert them to your presence.

ROE – Only other friendly will be Chalis. Any other contact can be considered hostile.

Ordinance – Air to air weapons choice is free. We do not have any AGM 88s available but any other none nuclear weapons can be chosen for this mission.
