BACKGROUND

The situation in the Aegean is at a stalemate with both sides suffering huge losses. However Command do not want to give the enemy time to regroup quicker than they are.

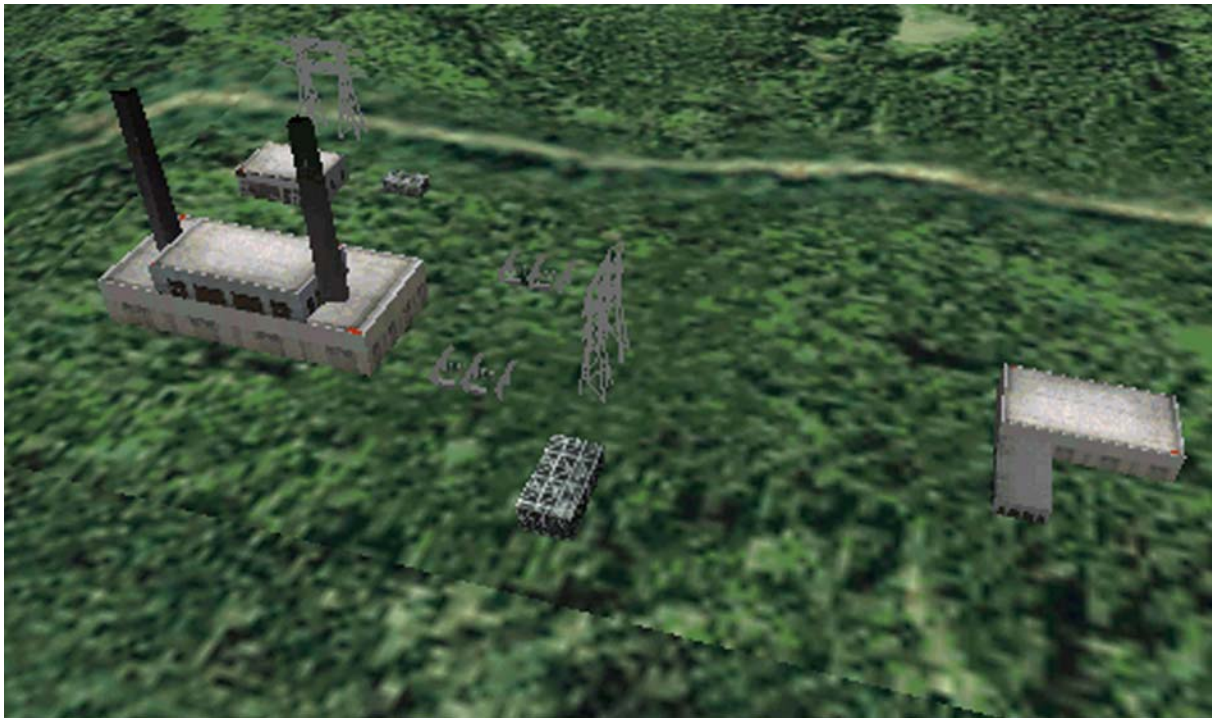
CURRENT SITUATION

Command recognises the importance of stopping the enemy re-supply their already formidable forces and so measures must be taken to slow or stop it all together.

MISSION DETAILS

Mission – Your task is to help stop all production in the Bihac area.

Target – Your target is Bihac power station. It must be put out of action.



Weather – The winds are from 180° at 5 knots. Visibility is excellent.

Enemy – The enemy has a considerable number of high quality air and ground assets that you must be aware of, including active air threats and very high quality SAMs.

Friendly – WE have awacs operating in the north but we expect them to be out of range of some air threats in your area.

A two ship DCA will cover your return over the coast if needed.

Route – The route is free but this is likely to be the best route, though the final decision is yours.

ROE – Beware of friendlies on the way home. No other friendlies are operating in the sortie zone.
