CURRENT SITUATION

China has stepped in to support their allies in the north by agreeing to supply armour. We have learned that they will be crossing the Donggou bridge with the supply column at around 05:15 giving us plenty of time to hit the bridge and prevent the re-supply to the DPRK.

MISSION DETAILS

8 F-16C-52's from the 185th have been given the task of making sure that the DPRK do not receive the armour re-supply. Cowboy has been tasked with making sure Falcon 1 reach the bridge to drop their bombs.

SA-6N missile equipped ships spotted West of Kwail airbase.

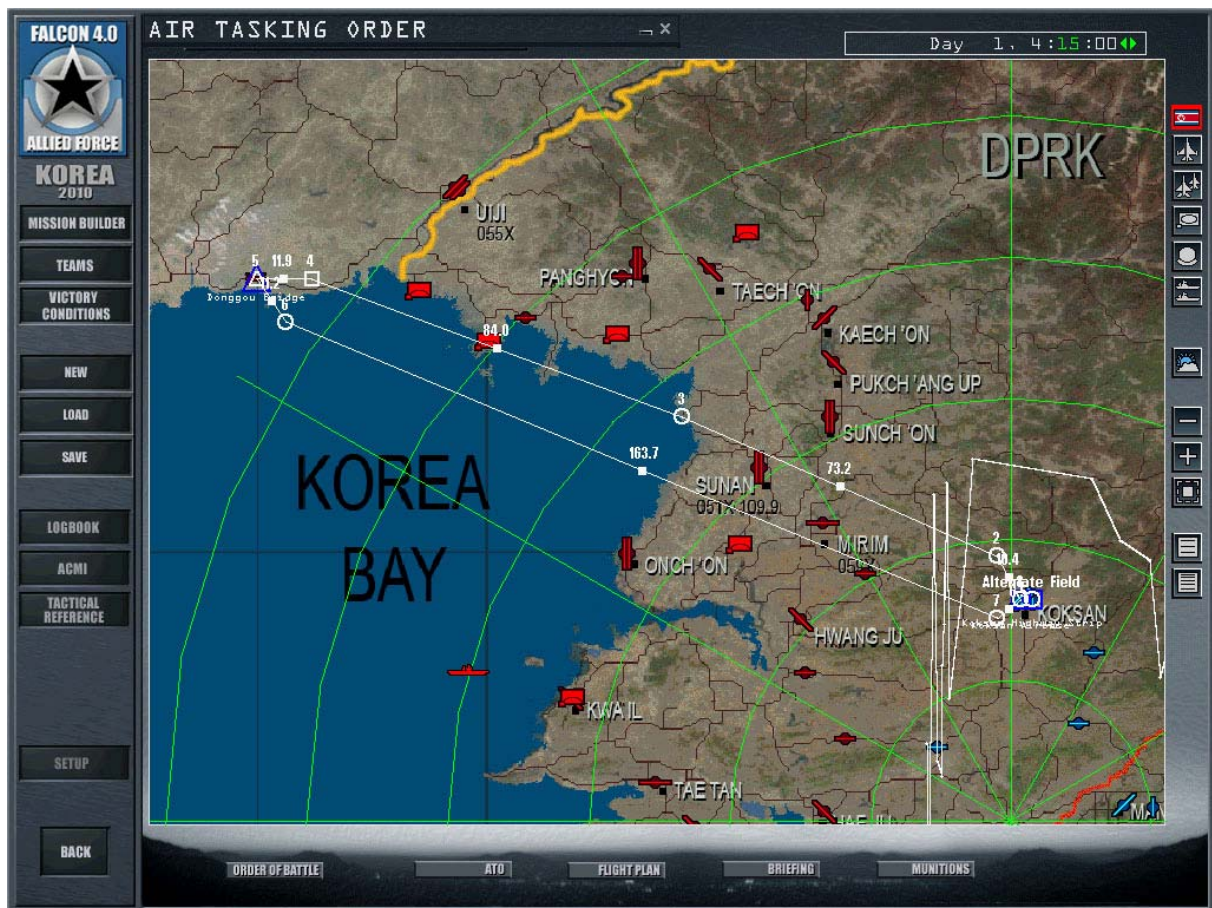
