BACKGROUND

The Cheonan sinking occurred on March 26, 2010, when the Cheonan, a South Korean Navy ship carrying 104 personnel, sank off the country's west coast near Baengnyeong Island in the Yellow Sea. The report of an investigation carried out by a team of international experts was released on May 20, 2010, concluding that the warship had been sunk by a North Korean torpedo, fired by a midget submarine. To date, 40 bodies have been recovered out of 46 seamen who went down with the ship.

Baengnyeong Island is a South Korean island in the Yellow Sea, off the Ongjin peninsula in North Korea. It lies less than 10 miles (16 km) from the North Korean coast, and is over 100 miles (160 km) from the South Korean mainland. The island is to the west of the Northern Limit Line, the *de facto* boundary dividing South Korea (ROK) from North Korea (DPRK). The area is the site of considerable tension between the two states; although it was provided in the armistice agreement for the stalemate of the Korean war that the islands themselves belonged to the South, the sea boundary was not covered by the armistice, and the sea is claimed by the North. The situation is complicated by the presence of a rich fishing ground, used by DPRK and Chinese fishing vessels and there have been numerous clashes over the years between naval vessels from both sides, attempting to police what both sides regard as their territorial waters. These have been referred to as the Crab wars. In 2009 there were several incidents, notably an action in November 2009 which left a DPRK vessel severely damaged, and as recently as January 2010 an exchange of fire took place near Baengnyeong island.

CURRENT SITUATION

Diplomatic efforts failed to get to a resolution. Decision makers issued an attack on Pipa-Got seaport. Meanwhile, Cheonan has been recovered from the sea and on it's way back to ROK's seaports onboard a cargo ship, DPRK's naval ships could be seen from distance.

USS Carrier Force Roosevelt has joined the region to provide support to ROK naval forces and US land based forces. The carrier group will provide vital role in our mission today.

Enemy

The enemy as we all know is well equipped. Numerous, highly advanced SAM's are reported through DPRK's territory, including but not limited to: SA-10, SA-17, and SA-6, as well as some advanced jets including MiG-29S's and J-11's. Check OoB from more information on their air assets.

DPRK has deployed few Ulsan frigates and OSAN boats, and they are on patrol just north of ROK's naval ships.

Friendly

ROK naval forces have some destroyers and frigates already deployed in the region, some of them are capable of intercepting air targets.

USS Carrier group will provide AEW & ECM support through E-2C & EA-6B prowlers. Another 4 ship F/A-18E "Super Hornet" are assigned to take out Ulsan group just to the North West.
