BACKGROUND

Despite the resounding political coup of having the Chinese Republic ally themselves with us, the DPRK seem set on openly continuing with their preparations for an invasion of the ROK. Consequently tensions are high in China, as well as in all of Korea.

CURRENT SITUATION

It has been decided that a message needs to be sent to the DPRK that will hopefully awaken them to the immense military might that is to the north and south of it's borders. This will hopefully convince them to stand down and look to develop better relationships with its neighbours.

MISSION DETAILS

Mission – Command has decided to make a two pronged attack into the heart of the DPRK. One flight shall come from our new station in China, while the other will come from the ROK. The success of both missions will prove to the DPRK that if we can attack their heartland then all of the DPRK is open to attack and that any large scale conflict would be disastrous for them.

Target – Commanders you have a choice of mission planned for this coming Sunday, though they are the same kind of mission and roughly the same distance. Your choice will dictate which airbase you and your squadron are moved to.

The targets are two underground factory complexes, both roughly 23nm east-west of each other. Should you decide upon the eastern target you will fly from Uiju AB, in China. The western target will be targeted by a squadron from Kimpo AB.

Below are reconnaissance photos of each target site.

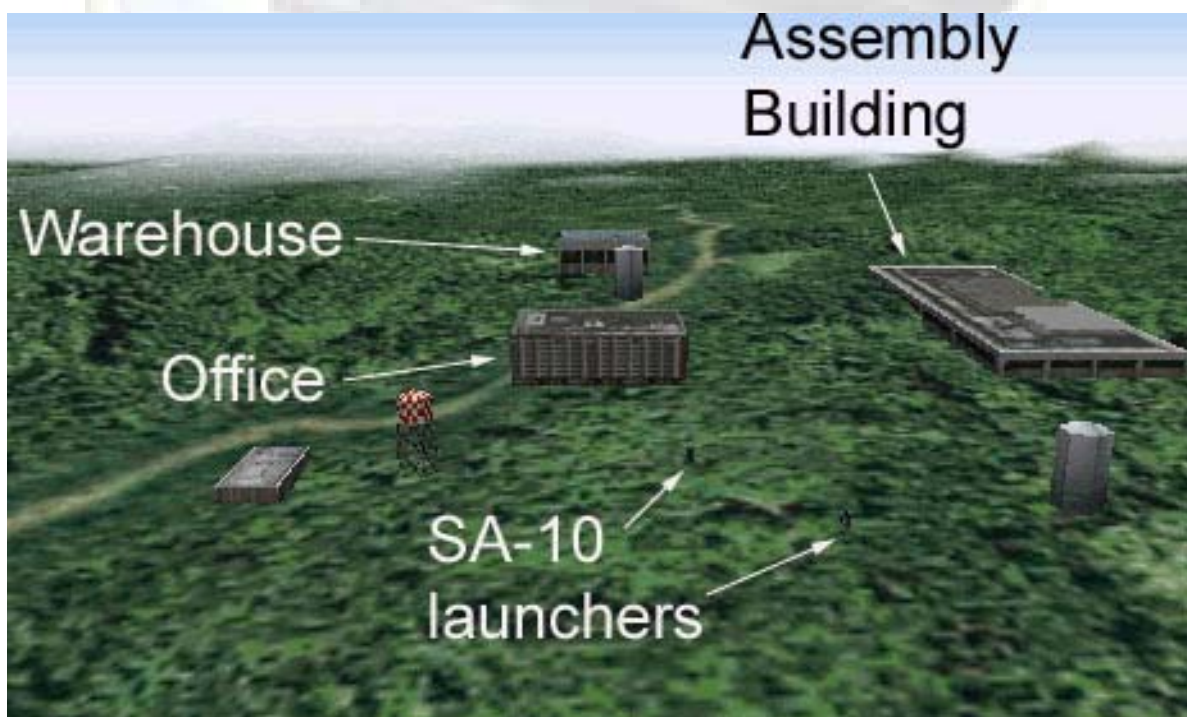


Fig 1: Eastern target for Kimpo squadron.

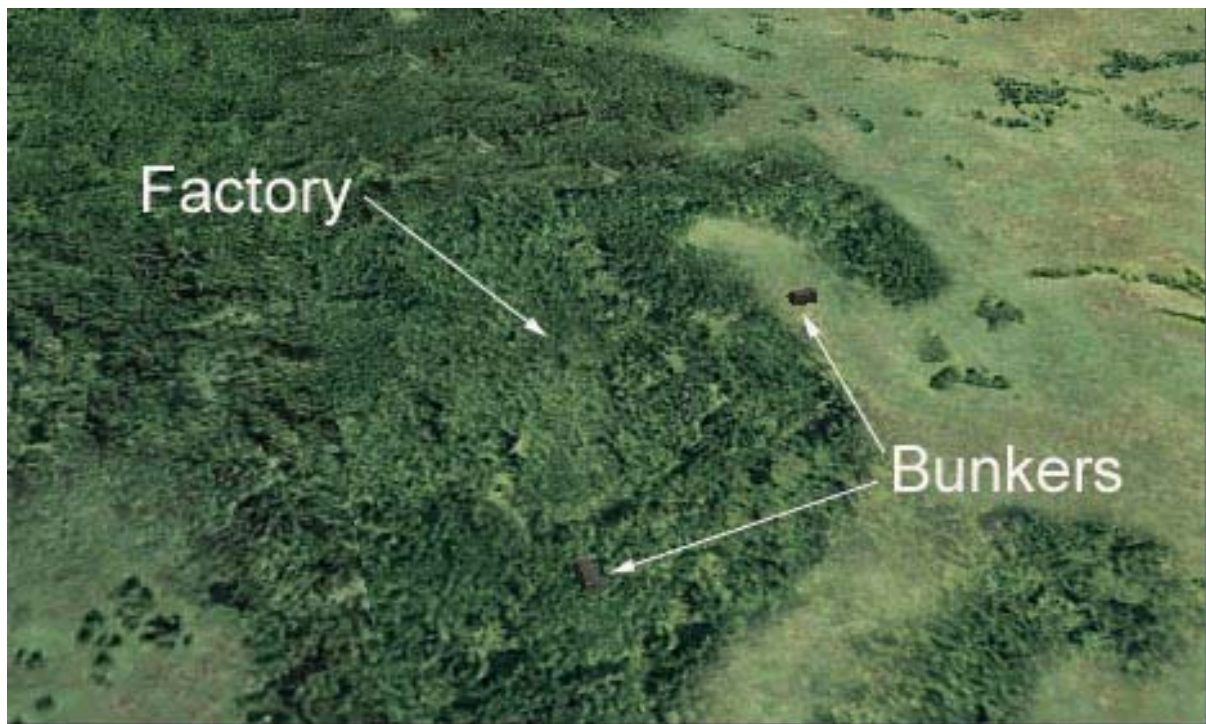


Fig 2: Western target for Uiju squadron.

Weather – Gentlemen, you have a clear afternoon ahead of you with 5 knot winds from the south. Con layer is still at 30,000 feet.

Enemy – The enemy will not be expecting you but they have considerable amounts of paranoia, in this case it is justified. There are multiple static and mobile SAM sites and AAA battalions on alert throughout the country, as well as air patrols by high threat aircraft. You should also note that DPRK aircraft carriers are stationed off shore on both the east and west coasts. This should not worry you unless you go “feet wet”.

Friendly – This is a political strike and not all out war. Consequently, you will be on your own, except for information on the air picture from an AWACs in the ROK.

ROE – Choose your targets carefully as no other targets outside of SAM/AAA and your designated site should be damaged, eg if you damage another building at your target site, that is acceptable. You cannot pick another ground target such as an army base during your mission.
