BACKGROUND

The United Allied Empire (UAE) has nearly removed all of it's perceived threats to democracy from the world map. Part of this is the destruction of the Chinese communist state in South Korea; then Japan will be next.

CURRENT SITUATION

The South Koreans are putting up a determined fight, helped by a tremendous effort to resupply their forces.

MISSION DETAILS

Mission – The steel mill at Taejon is producing the enemy with the means to construct new armour. This must be stopped.

Target – Your task is to destroy the four factories at the mill and destroy the warehouse containing already processed steel.

Weather – Tell them the weather is. Ensure it is accurate and give, as a minimum, the following information: -

- a. Take-off time.
- b. Weather over home plate (including cloud base, visibility, temperature, wind speed and wind direction).
- c. Weather over the target (including cloud base and visibility).

Sometimes b and c are the same and there is no need to repeat the information. If using Weather AF you must try to give as accurate information as you can.

Enemy – The enemy has plenty of 3rd and 4th generation aircraft left to hold us back. There are also plenty of static and mobile SAM's and AAA that they will use to protect their assets.

Friendly – Apart from your package there is only the AWACs in the air. We also have some ground troops setting up on our side of the FLOT.

NOTE The F-15C flight can be flown by real pilots if you wish, but this must be balanced against the requirements of the mission. Both F-16 flights must be manned with at least two 185th pilots. The target must be destroyed.
