## BACKGROUND

Tension continues to mount Between North and South Korea. The North has shelled the island of Yeonpyeong, killing at least four South Koreans. Pyongyang said it had been provoked by the South's military exercises, which were being carried out close to Yeonpyeong, and by recent air attacks on it's nuclear plants. The US has called on China to increase its pressure on Pyongyang to prevent further incidents.

## CURRENT SITUATION

Western intelligence has discovered an audacious plan by Pyongyang to destroy a South Korean Nuclear Plant in the early hours of tomorrow morning. Both the USAF and RoKAF will be mounting Combat Air Patrols around the clock at all Nuclear Plants until such times as there is no longer a threat or any raid has been repelled.

## MISSION DETAILS

The 185<sup>th</sup> Virtual Fighter Squadron will mount Combat Air Patrols near Suwon Nuclear Plant between 01:00 and 01:45 or until any attack is repulsed should it occur during the squadron's patrol time. Efforts are being made to recall squadron personnel. If there are 8 pilots available they are to fly the Cowboy1 and Falcon1 flights. The AI squadron will fly a CAP over Seochean Nuclear Plant to the South in LOBO1. However if we have 12 pilots for this mission, then they can take LOBO1 and assist in patrolling at Suwon.

### Target

Your target is any DPRK military aircraft that have crossed into Southern air space and are deemed to be a threat to Suwon Nuclear Plant

### Weather

The weather forecast is for a warm, clear night with excellent visibility. The con layer will be 30,000 and there will be a gentle 5 knot breeze from 180°.

### Enemy

The DPRK are on high alert. Their air defence system is ready to go. Do not cause further political fallout by encroaching North Korean air space.

DPRK air force assets include the highly capable SU-27SM fighter, SU-39 ground attack aircraft and the potent TU-95MS 'BEAR' strategic bomber. We are aware that DPRK stocks of active homing missiles are currently unavailable due to sabotage. Therefore any SU-27SM fighters encountered will be equipped with R27R and R73 missiles.

### Friendly

There will be no other fighter support available as we are stretched to the limit mounting Combat Air Patrols at all Nuclear Plants across the country. Air Defense of Suwon is also covered by the patriot missile batteries of the 1067<sup>th</sup> Air Defense based at Seoul air base, and the 1031<sup>st</sup> AAA battalion which are garrisoned at Suwon.

ELINT Support will be provided by E3 AWAC patrolling central RoK.

### Route

You must remain within the area of your assigned CAP at Suwon. If LOBO1 flight is used, it must also patrol the area of Suwon Nuclear Plant.

### ROE

You are free to attack any military unit entering RoK air space which has been declared hostile by AWACS, or is deemed to be a threat to yourselves or to the RoK .

### Ordnance

Your load out is free. Take what you feel necessary to do the job.
