CURRENT SITUATION

North Korea is starting to move! In a classical soviet doctrine, its ground forces are running south with ample support of mobile air defenses. At the moment we identified two attack echelons moving parallel south. According to our intelligence, each echelon is composed of an assault unit (usually a BMP-based unit) followed by a tank battallion (T-80 or T-72). These units are supported by extensive air support and mobile/AAA coverage. The latest intelligence from our satellites suggests the enemy forward forces will cross the border around 16:30 local time.

MISSION DETAILS

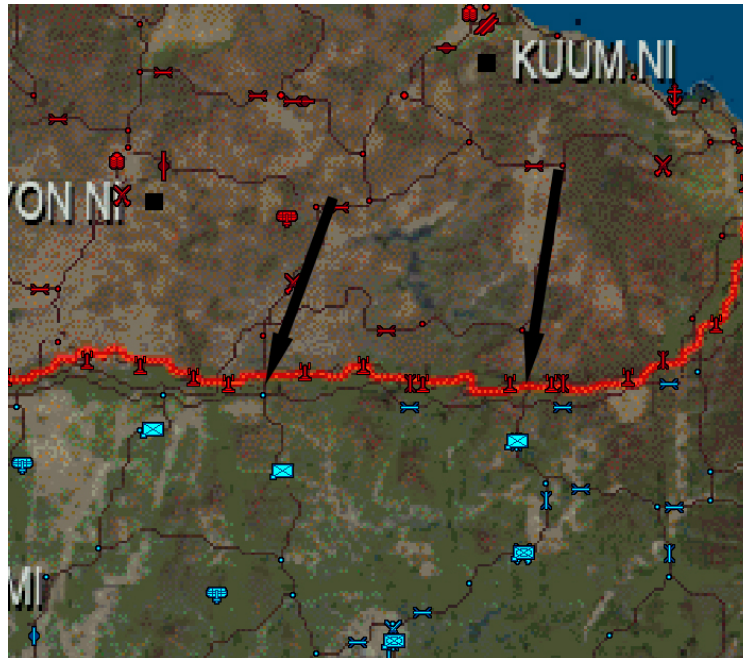
Weather – Weather seems stable with light cloud coverage near to the target area.

Enemy – North Korea possesses several high-threat 4th generation aircraft (for example SU-35 and MiG-29SM) capable of carrying the R-77 as well as 3rd generation low-threat vectors like the MiG-23.

On the ground, satellites confirm the extensive employment of mobile double and single digit SAM units.

Friendly – Check ATO for friendly air units operating in your area.

Mission – Our mission is to **engage and destroy a SA-17 battalion** supporting north Korean tank and motorized infantry units. The SA-17 battalion is operating with the west attack echelon. Due to coordination with joint forces, the SA-17 battalion must be disabled before 16:45 local time.



Target – The SA-17 Grizzly is an advanced medium-range SAM system of the BUK family. It is a very capable weapon, able to engage supersonic targets from 100 feet up to 82000 feet at a max range of about 30nm. In general, its nominal effective range is around 20nm. Each launcher has its own guidance radar.



SPECIAL RULE FOR THIS TE: Human AWACS (or any other pilot in the User Interface) **is not allowed** to offer either BDA on enemy ground units or position of enemy ground units, which are under attack or not. Its only task is to support the mission package on the air-to-air picture.
