BACKGROUND

It happened in November 2009 that the two Nuclear Plants in Hamhung and Togwon-ni exploded with devastating collateral damage and contaminated the area. The few people who survived the catastrophe formed a trek and started to move south, towards the border between North and South Korea. They hoped for medical care in modern hospitals. The President of North Korea, Po'Li Tuk, held imperialistic terrorists responsible for the assault, but changed his mind when a Chinese SpecOps team was arrested a week later. The true circumstances unveiled and after days of hectic diplomatic actions the frontier to South Korea was opened for refugees.

Some nationalist groups in North and South Korea that want to keep the status quo, have voted against any diplomatic negotiations and brought several military key locations in south-west Korea under their control.

CURRENT SITUATION

The Nationalists want to support the key locations in the South and are sending cargo ships from Pupo-ri Naval Base to Mokpo Port. It was possible to destroy the port in an earlier mission, but the enemy managed to get at least an engineer and tank battalion ashore. Fuel is needed badly to keep the tanks rolling, so two tankers are anchored in the beach head.

MISSION DETAILS

Mission

Destroy the two tankers to stop the fuel support.

Weather


Wind: 294° @ 10 kts

Vis: 11 nm. Excellent

Enemy

Expect modern fighters with active missiles and SAM sites (Patriot, SA-5). We know about one active Patriot site at Kunsan Airbase and another - not yet active one - at Kwangju Airbase, but HQ thinks the code breaker will activate the site within the next few hours.

Several frigates patrol the south-west coast.

You can expect the tanker to hoist anchor and flee north once our intentions are clear. Fly close to the TOT and minimize playtime over the target area.
