BACKGROUND

Things have not been going well for the allies and we are in the middle of a weakening defence. We are holding on while we try to evacuate as many people as possible to Japan.

CURRENT SITUATION

The DPRK has captured vital air bases and army bases in the SW of Korea and is likely to make a push for Kwangju AB which would ensure their control of the whole of the SW.

MISSION DETAILS

Mission – Package 1986 has a two fold job to do here, such is the desperate situation we find ourselves in.

Firstly, they must ensure a flight of four C-17's full of evacuees, can get away safely to Japan. We must not lose any more innocent civilians to this war.

Secondly, they must clear a route for Bone 1 who are going to attack Kunsan AB in a bid to slow the advance of the DPRK.

There are numerous AD battalions that threaten the success of both tasks, not least a suspected SA-10 at the radar site at Chonju, that would have the limits of it's launch envelope fairly close to home plate, so be careful.



Weather – The weather for this mission is bright and clear.

Enemy – The enemy has spread it's air force across the FLOT but there are still serious threats in the zone and you will be required to eliminate all that the mission deems necessary.

Ground forces are on the move south and they include mobile SAM.

Friendly – Two friendly tank battalions will be heading north to intercept but they are outnumbered and will hold as long as possible. All friendly aircraft are in the package information table.
