BACKGROUND

The push against the northern hordes has gone well in the east but we are slow to get over the border in the west.

CURRENT SITUATION

We are preparing for a concerted assault on the western border. We have had reports that two new battalions of tanks have been delivered up river to Chaeryong and then to the army corp base to the east. These need to be crippled before we commence our invasion.

MISSION DETAILS

Mission – Two Pre plan CAS flights shall attack each new tank battalion. A SEAD escort of F-16-52C will escort them and clear any radar SAM threats out of the way.

Target – Cowboy one will attack the 1067th tank battalion at the old SAM site and Falcon the 1031st tank battalion at the army base to the east. There are other units in the area with known manpad capabilities, so be alert.

Weather –

- a. All flights take off with a minute of each other from 09:10hrs.
- b. Temp – 31°C
Wind – 12 knots from 310°

Enemy – SAM threats are known to include SA-2, 3 and 6, though there may be others. IR threats will be a threat at low level.

Enemy air assets are known to have limited supplies of Adder missiles so prepare you're A-A strategy accordingly.

Friendly – AWACs and JSTARs will be on station by the time you get airborne.

Route – Push point for Cowboy and Falcon is fixed and it is recommended that you follow Fury as they clear your path. You may move SP3 as long as the timings are adjusted to match for Cowboy and Falcon

Ordnance – Ordnance as per schedule on page one.

NOTE FOR FURY – Should you wish to add tanks or extra A-G weapons on the empty pylons you are free to do so. No extra A-A weapons are permitted.
