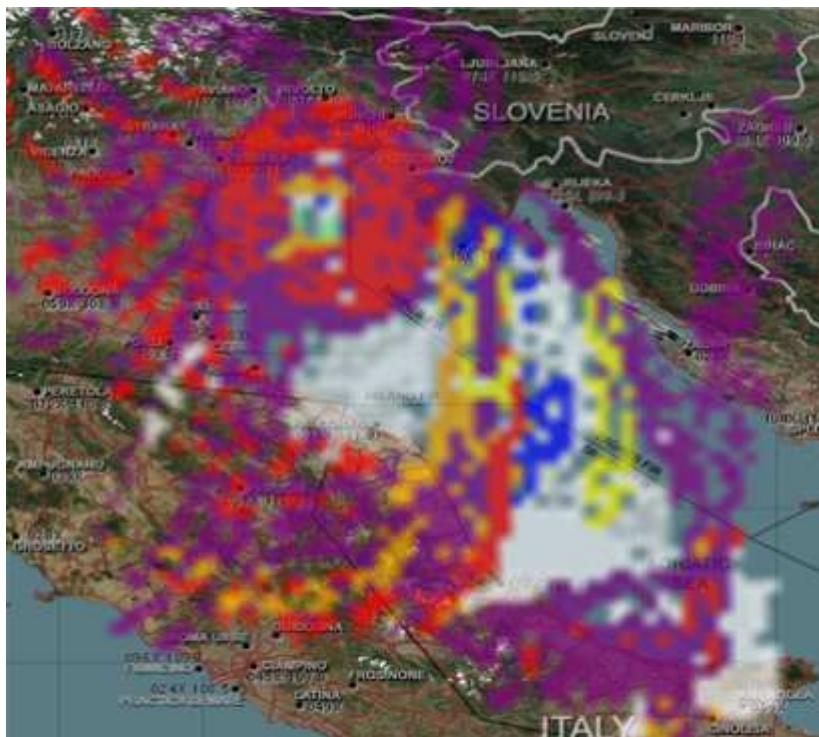
that we must take advantage. A small weather opening is moving towards Tula and we are expecting a 10 minute window of good weather at around 9:40.

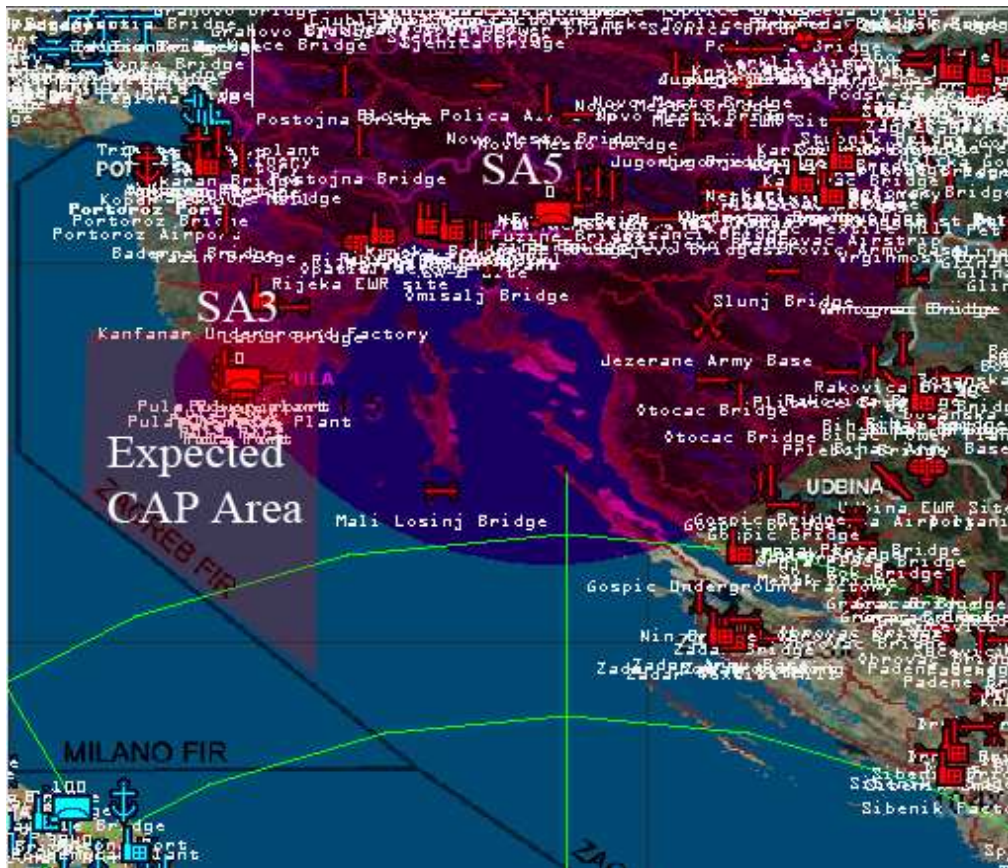
### MISSION DETAILS

Weather – In a few words: Mayhem. Winds 50@290. Thunderstorms with a cloud base of 3000ft tops at 16000ft+ almost all the way to Pula.

Contrails expected at MSL A30 to A36



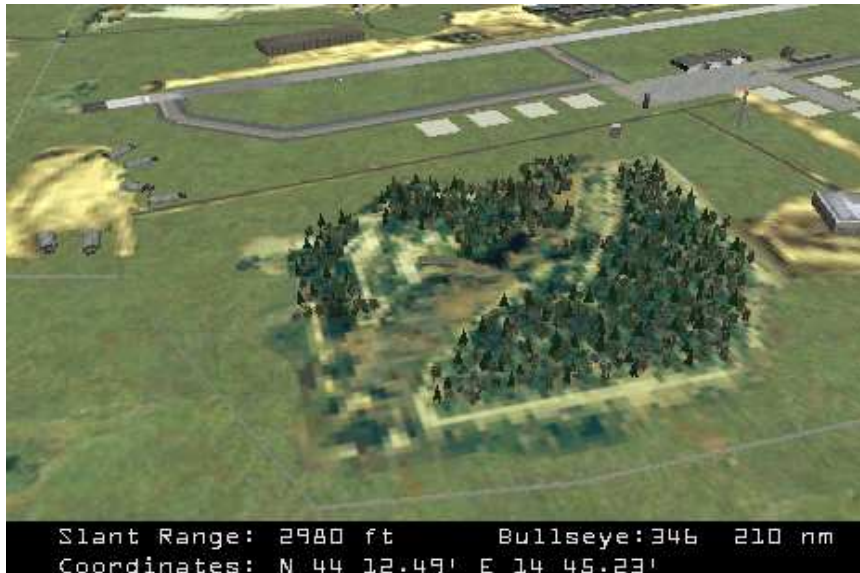
Enemy – Enemy has several squadrons of 3rd and 4th generation aircrafts. Intel reports that their Su27SM's are R77M capable. An SA3 is covering the area. There's also an SA5 east of Pula that can be avoided at low level. Since the enemy is not expecting a hit, no great air resistance is expected.



Friendly – AWACS and JSTAR aircrafts will be flying near Pescara, providing picture.

Target – Targets are the radio tower and the ammo dump at Pula Airbase. Due to the high winds, use of CCRP or high drag ammunition is not advised.
