BACKGROUND

The war against the aggressive invaders from the north has been going in the allie's favour for nearly three months now and the United Nations has passed resolution 79956, allowing the allied forces to push into the invader's home soil, in order to create a neutral buffer zone between them and the south.

CURRENT SITUATION

The first phase of creating the neutral zone has been running for two weeks and is concentrating on the eastern side of the country. It is on this side that the highest concentration of enemy forces is thought to be. It is believed that if these are crushed then the North will capitulate and allow the central and western sections of the neutral zone to be created without military conflict.

MISSION DETAILS

Our armoured battalions are pushing north east to cut off the south part of the North Korean south western peninsular (clear as mud eh?). With CAS units available, they are confident of dealing with enemy forces currently on the ground.

Intel has told us that T-90 tank battalions are en-route to reinforce the enemy and are due to cross the bridge at Chanong-ni. They must not be allowed to cross. AMD have shown no interest!

Weather – Conditions are poor.

Winds – 14 knots from 283°

Temperature – -9°C

Visibility – 40%

Fog altitude – 3000'

Enemy – The enemy have good high level threats available in the form of aircraft and SAM systems. Mig 29S, Mig 31, Su 27 and others are known to be on alert. An SA-10 and other static and mobile SAM threats are known and suspected to exist.

There is no current naval threats.

Friendly – AWACs and JSTAR. There are other missions in the air during your mission. Check the package information and be sure of your target.

Mission – Your mission is to destroy the Chanong-ni bridge while maintaining air superiority and aggressively defending against SAM threats. All other targets of opportunity are free to engage.

Target – The bridge below consists of five separate targets, all of which must be destroyed to make life harder for the enemy's engineer battalions to build a combat bridge.

Route – The route for this mission is free.

ROE - Be sure of your target, particularly in the air. Remember, only Cowboy flight can attack the bridge. Attacks by any of Falcon and Fury on the bridge will be an instant mission failure.
