BACKGROUND

Ground troops have captured enemy intel which have provided a possible location on a Korean high value target codenamed Gingerbread, a 2 Ship of B-1 bombers have been tasked to perform a unannounced precision strike under the cover of darkness in an attempt to assassinate the high value target whilst his location is still known.

CURRENT SITUATION

The B1's successfully hit their target no less than 5 minutes ago; we have intercepted a enemy comms transmission that confirms that Gingerbread is still alive. Reports have shown when our ground forces captured the Intel they were unable destroy enemy comms equipment before the enemy was able to broadcast back to HQ, so we believe that the enemy HQ have been alerted that we know of the HVT's location, which meant that the HVT had been extracted before the attack had taken place and is now heading North. A forward observing recon squad have reported that the HVT enroute moving north in a convoy of APC's. We suspect that the convoy is headed to the enemy stronghold in Wonsan which is heavily guarded by armour and anti air battalions, we expect the surprise strike will have alerted nearby airbases and have been scrambled to assist with the extraction, several F-16's were put on alert status in case the B-1 strike is a failure, your task is to search and destroy the HVT's convoy before it reaches the enemy stronghold of Wonsan.

MISSION DETAILS

Mission –

Gypsy Flight - Your task is to set up BARCAP overhead of the convoy and to stop any advancing air threats

Avenger Flight - Intel Reports suggest several static SAM sites are located along the route to Wonsan, without these SAM threats suppressed then Cobra flight shall not be able to get into range to attack the convoy

Cobra Flight - No solid location information can be provided on the HVT however as long as you do not arrive before caret then the HVT be travelling north between steerpoint 5 and steerpoint 6, your task is to locate the convoy and destroy all APC's before your targets passes Steerpoint 6, after this point the anti air threats will be too focussed to pursue the target any further.

Target – 3713rd Mech Battalion this convoy is mobile so GMT radar mode can be used to help locate the targets, however enemy armour has also been spotted moving South from Wonsan so you'll need to confirm you have the right group before engaging.

Avoid getting too close to Wonsan as multiple SA-2 sites are covering this area.

Weather –

a. Weather reports show the weather will be mainly fair, good visibility scattered clouds and low winds during take off and time on target, later reports show a possibility of the weather degrading into a storm which may make the return journey bumpy.

Enemy Air – Enemy Mig 23's are based at Wonsan so will have most likely already have been scrambled before your package reaches the target, Also in the area you should expect flights of Mig 21's and the possibility of Mig 29A/S squadron based in the North East.

Enemy Ground - Most ground threats are stationary so ensure to take your time to learn and recon the enemy efficiently expect multiple SA-2's, SA-4's, a single SA-5 and multiple AAA units.

Friendly – Sentry 2 - AWACS will be operating South of Homeplate

Camel 1 - Tanker will be operating near steerpoint 2 and 6 however due to timing restrictions this is primarily for use if fuel is low after egress.

Bone 2 - Will be executing a precision strike attack minutes before our take off time, bear in mind these will be RTB and you may pick up as radar contacts.

Route – Steerpoint 4 - 5 mark the enemies route, it is not advisable to adjust these or their time on station, also if the target passes steerpoint 5, you will be well inside Wonsan's SA-2 no escape envelopes so it is recommended you do not continue to engage the target after this point.

ROE - All assets over the border are considered hostile
