Makp'o Must Fall

Gentlemen, this mission is designed to rob the DPRK of the fifth largest port in Korea and if successful, should present the enemy with devastating supply problems and within weeks, should allow our ground forces to put an end to the DPRK's stranglehold on the south western tip of the peninsula.

Please note that Weapons & Steerpoints are fixed!!

Within the last few hours, Special Recon Forces have smuggled out the following intelligence:



Before receiving this report, we believed the area was **much** more heavily defended. The adjacent airbase is now known to be inactive and the only real threats are the AAA and SA-2 site. Of course nearby Kwangju Airbase is still operational, but we believe that the only active aircraft stationed there is a squadron of MiG-19's. We cannot however confirm this.

The Port of Mokp'o is our primary target and you are expected to inflict substantial damage to all the buildings on the site. Flight Leaders should study the recon pictures contained within this document and assign targets to individual pilots prior to take-off. The prime targets **MUST** be the main buildings, especially the Port Control Center shown below:





Any shipping in and around the port should be considered as low-value secondary targets and should only be attacked upon completion of the primary goal and secondary goals.



Your secondary target is the Makp'o Bridge which is essential to the DPRK for quick transportation routes out of the port. There are no recon photos of the bridge or surrounding area. Defences are also unknown.
