The unthinkable has happened, a large portion of the ROK forces have turned against us! They now control a large area in the central regions of the peninsula.

This rebellion must be crushed, or we are doomed!

Be careful, these forces have the same equipment we do!

We'll not only be up against the inferior DPRK stuff here, the rebels have F-15, F-16, F-5, F-4 and both Patriot and Hawk ADS battallions.

The ONLY edge we have is that only the rebel F-16s have Aim-120, the others have only Aim-7 as BVR missiles.

The first package is NOT for human use (in Green below), waiting time on clock screen would be too long. The other three are allowed for human use.

Package 3726 is F-18 4-ship, that shall strike a HQ batt. at a airbase. A dangerous task! A-A loadouts are fixed, A-G free choice.

Package 3732 is F-16 2-ship, that are to strike an airbase.

A-A loadouts are fixed, A-G free choice.

Package 3730 is F-16 2-ship, that are to strike a AAA battallion. A-A loadouts are fixed, A-G free choice.

All steerpoints are free to move as you see fit for the human packages.

INTEL:

On the airbase nearby the AAA battallion both F4 and F-16 are based, so beware of scambling aircraft.

The rebels will surely have CAP flights in the air so watch out for them. Stay on time, or you might get your hands full.....

Finally, beware of the ADA! Patriot, Hawk and SA5 will be encountered.

The DPRK have not yet fully realised what a fix we are in, so they have not yet any major air presence... but MiG-29 and SU-27 are available in the region.
