Our job is to destroy it.

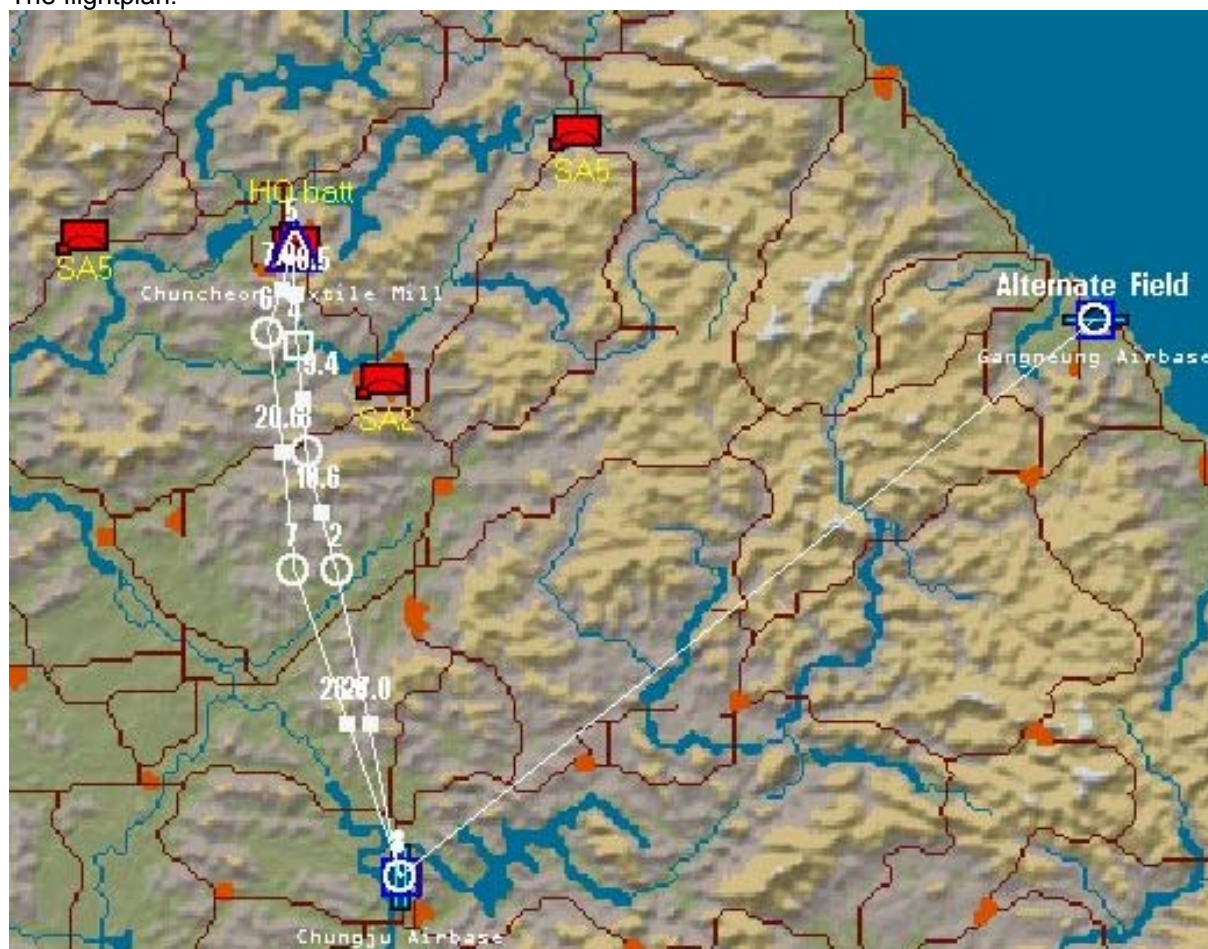
We will use four F-16C:s for the task.
Loadouts and steerpoints are free.

Target recon photo:



As you see it is a relatively small building, not easy to spot visually.

The flightplan:



As you see, the enemy has heavy ADA coverage over the entire area.

Any attack should be low-level, as we will not have the time to take out all 3 SA:s before striking the target.

Why? Simple: the enemy are aware that we will try our best to hit that lab before it's secrets are revealed, and that our Squadron is the nearest one.

Enemy Mainstay AWACS aircraft will pick up our strike flight not far after takeoff, and the enemy will surely scramble fighters to protect the lab. With some luck we will be able to hit the target, but do NOT dwell in the area! The chances are that incoming fighters will ruin your day..... they won't be taking this hands-down for sure.

They have transferred crack squadrons to the area, SU-27s are stationed at Seoul and Kuam-Ni. MiG-25s are stationed at Hyon airbase. The -25s are old but very fast, beware so they don't surprise you!

Be aware that taking up the fight with enemy aircraft is very risky in case you fly low, you will then be down in the weeds while the enemy will be at high altitude which will give them an advantage.

The importance of this mission can not be stressed enough.
