Mission 26/05/01 – One Way Trip

Gentleman, you may be wondering why we had you fly here from Kunsan airbase on such short notice. We have suspected for a while that the underground factory located to the east of the town of Sambae-ri was not producing medicines as claimed but war materials. This has finally been confirmed by a one of our intelligence operatives.

You are tasked with destroying this facility.

We are aware of AAA and an SA3 site defending the factory and have monitored heavy air activity in the factories immediate vicinity. We believe SU27 BARCAPS and Mig 21 SWEEP flights patrol the area around the factory on a regular schedule.

We have allocated as many friendly aircraft for support as we can muster on short notice. You will see your ingress and egress routes are protected by F15 and F18C BARCAPS. You have also been assigned an escort flight of 2xF15C's, callsign Mustang 1. A SWEEP mission carried out by F18C's is due on target approximately 5 minutes before you, it is imperative that you do not get there before them. It is their job, and that of your ESCORT to engage any BARCAP flights over the target area, not yours. I can guarantee you will have enough to contend with without worrying about enemy aircraft.

Due to depth the factory facility is buried into the countryside the weapon to be used is the BLU109 penetrator bomb. We would advise you to load your package for a dual STRIKE and SEAD escort role as we are unable to provide any SEAD coverage.

Your package designation for this mission is <u>3685</u> and comprises of 4 x F16's, callsign Cowboy 1.

Default Loadout:-

Cowboy 1&2 - 4xAIM120 (SEAD/ESCORT) 1xAIM9M

6xCBU58A/B

1xAGM88

Cowboy 3&4 - 4xAIM120 (STRIKE/A-A) 2xBLU109/B Note: You may adjust aircraft loadouts as you see fit. Remember that the target is the Underground Factory. Cluster munitions are optional.


Only the BLU109 is allowed from the available bomb load. ie. No GBU's/MKxx/BSUxx etc.

Steerpoints are fixed.

As you can see from the recon photo which was taken at 10000ft from 6 miles there is not a lot to see at the target with the exception of the bunkers marking the north and south concealed entrances to the facility.

We would suggest your method of bomb release being CCIP with your pipper placed on the steerpoint diamond.

NB. 2 bomb hits are required to destroy the facility. We would therefore suggest you release your bombs in pairs.
