Precision Strike

Gentleman, the situation is grim, we have been informed by an intelligence operative that the DPRK have acquired an undisclosed number of operational F16 aircraft. 


Your task is two fold gentleman. Fly to Drang airbase destroying the runway and hanger housing the F16 aircraft.

As your flight plan takes you out to sea keep a lookout for airborne interceptors. Once you cross the coast on your run in to target you will be exposed to various AAA and SAM's, stay alert and do not get drawn into their engagements envelopes by patrolling aircraft. Reconnaissance footage of the

area indicates a less than expected level of air activity, we believe this is an attempt to keep the location of the F16 aircraft a secret by not drawing attention to the area. However, we are aware of a number of nearby Mig29 and SU27 squadrons that are on alert will without a doubt try their best to prevent you from successfully striking the target.



One more thing, as the title suggests this mission is about precision bombing. The assigned and only targets are the runway and the hanger. NO additional damage to the airbase can be tolerated, we want to make it quite clear to the DPRK authorities by such a precision strike that they can hide nothing from us.

For verification of damage to target area structures, a screen shot of the event list detailing bomb hits and damage must be submitted with debrief results.

Steerpoints are fixed.

Loadouts are completely at pilot discretion. Choose very wisely.
