Seal that salient

This is the situation:

Our ground forces have successfully trashed the DPRK:s Eastern front and have since then pushed north-westwards, aiming to create a salient and trap the remaining DPRK ground forces in the Pyongyang area.

The enemy is aware of this threat and have stationed strong forces in the remaining corridor along the west coast.

Our job will be to fly Interdiction against ground troops in the region to soften them up a bit while our ground forces resupply and regroup for the final assault.



The map:

We will fly package 3690, a 4-ship F-16C.

Loadouts are free, steerpoints are fixed.

Anything between stp3 and 4 is fair game.

The SA2 is not in range so it can be ignored, just don't stray into it's envelope!

Intel: Enemy fighters are based in the region, and Squadrons of MiG-19, 23, 25 and 29 are based not far from our target area so watch out. Agents report that DPRK air forces will do their best to thwart our efforts to smash through to

Agents report that DPRK air forces will do their best to thwart our enorts to smash through to the west coast, they even warned about the elite SU-27 Squadrons being brought into action! We have no intel on where those SU-27s are based so keep a sharp eye out for them! If you encounter them do not engage unless forced to it!

No Intel is available on whether the SU-27s have access to the AA-12 Adder or not.
