

The Phantom Menace

After two months of successful ground war where the Allied forces have pushed far north the DPRK pulled a nasty trick on us.

They have performed an amphibious assault in our rear on the east coast, capturing Kosong Airbase. They have also managed to land two T-62 battallions and a SA2 battallion in the area, which means they won't be very easy to dislodge.

To make matters even worse, due to the total surprise the enemy accieved they captured an entire F4-E squadron on the ground at Kosong! They are already flying those F4:s on offensive missions against our forces, although they perform rather poorly as they have not yet mastered the use of the equipment.

Nevertheless, that base and it's F4:s must be taken out!

We will fly our F-16s out of Sansago-Ri airbase, two F-16 will strike the runway and two will be Escort.

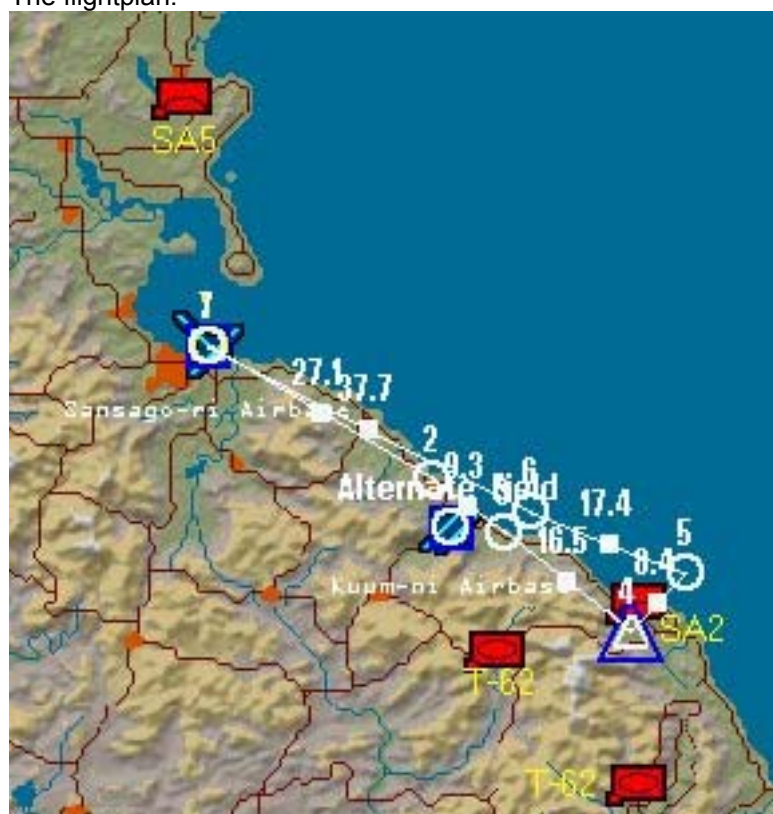
NOTE: Due to limited supplies we are limited to a total of 4 AIM-120!

So, that's an average of **ONE** per aircraft!

The flight leader of each 4-ship may decide on how to deploy these, 2 on each of the Escorts, one on all four aircraft or whatever he sees fit, as long as the TOTAL does not exceed 4.

Steerpoints are free, A-G loadouts are free, A-A are limited to maximum 4 Aim-120 in total (as described above) but Aim-9 use is unlimited.

INTEL:

As already described the enemy have F-4-E at Kosong, but there are also SU-27 and MiG-29 based to the north of our home plate.

No Intel available on whether the SU-27:s have AA-12 Adder available or not.

The SA5 just to the north of our base may be troublesome, it is well within range when we take off so be cautious of climbing too high.
